

Luxury Pret & Occasionwear – Women's Ethnic-Fusion Line

Silhouettes & Styles:

This collection merges traditional Bengali drapery and weaving with contemporary tailoring.

The silhouettes range from:

- Structured floor-length gowns with asymmetric drapes
  - Panelled A-line dresses with tribal motifs
- Fusion kurtas with cinched waists and minimal sleeves

Each silhouette honors the softness of handwoven Jamdani while exploring refined cuts and tailored fits.

#### **Color Palette:**

A rich, grounded palette evoking royalty and heritage:

- Burnt Rust
- Terracotta Red
- Warm Sand
- Ivory White
- Gold Accents
- · Subtle Black/Indigo motifs as contrast

**Fabric Suggestions:** 

- Handwoven Jamdani cotton & silk
  - Banarasi brocade with zari work

- Textured georgette or crepe for flowy panels

**Target Audience:** 

Avant-garde fashion enthusiasts, conceptual dressers, fashion-forward thinkers aged 20–35; individuals who appreciate literary references, emotional storytelling, and wearable art. Targeted toward niche high fashion clientele and gallery showcase collectors.

This is a collection steeped in emotion, rebellion, and the grotesque beauty of change.

#### **Fabric & Material Suggestions:**

Sculpted Neoprene: For carapace-inspired, cocooned forms. Crushed Velvet & Tulle: Reflects vulnerability, softness, and disarray.

Layered Mesh & Gauze: To simulate molting and transformation.

Iridescent Organza: Suggests insect-like iridescence and otherworldliness. Bonded Leather or Latex: For surreal, shell-like surfaces. Embroidered Netting & Beetle Motif Lace: For intricate textural storytelling.

#### **Color Palette:**

A muted, melancholic spectrum representing decay, surrealism, and earthbound transformation:

- Earthen Brown (#5A3E36)
  - Dusty Rose (#BF9981)
  - Moss Green (#3C4D3B) Sepia Gray (#A49A87) Shadow Black (#1C1C1C)

Accents may include hints of beetle iridescence (greens, purples, bronze, silver) for dramatic highlights.



**Target Audience:** 

Creative, emotionally expressive individuals aged 20–35, including fashion-forward artists, performers, and collectors of wearable art. This collection also appeals to those attending high-concept events, gallery shows, and experimental fashion showcases.

**Fabric and Material Suggestions:** 

- Chiffon & Organza: To represent fragility, vulnerability, and lightness (for emotions like sadness or serenity).
- Structured Neoprene & Sculpted Silk: To express repressed or intense emotions (anger, tension, strength).

Tulle & Mesh Layers: Symbolizing complexity and emotional layers.

- Metallic Foils & Vinyl: For futuristic emotional shielding or heightened states like euphoria or anxiety.
- Hand-painted textures, embroidery, or raw edges to evoke a handcrafted emotional signature.
- Soft lambskin leather/ Distressed or Cracked leather: Symbolizing vunerability, suppressed strength and emotional resilience.
