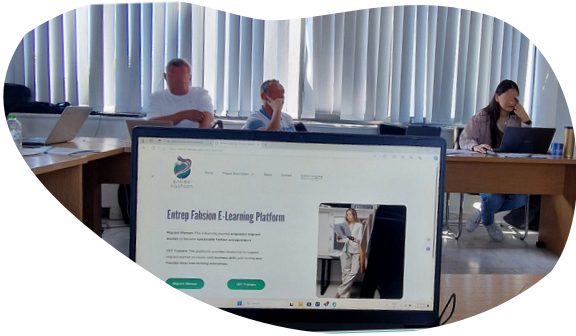


# EMPOWERING CHANGE THROUGH SUSTAINABLE FASHION: ENTREP FASHION PILOT TRAINING

This training is designed to empower migrant women and support VET (Vocational Education and Training) trainers, providing them with the tools and knowledge to excel in the sustainable fashion sector.

## KEY HIGHLIGHTS:

### For Migrant Women – Building Skills for the Future of Fashion:

Our pilot training offered participants valuable insights into recycling, upcycling, and navigating the legal aspects of starting a fashion business. The course also helped them connect with industry networks, opening doors to new opportunities.

Based on feedback, we plan to update the content on sustainable materials and include more modern examples of eco-friendly practices. This will ensure the training stays relevant for all participants as they pursue careers in sustainable fashion.

### For VET Trainers – Empowering Educators to Lead the Change:

VET trainers shared how the course enhanced their ability to guide participants, with many reporting increased skills in career counseling and understanding legal frameworks. Trainers were especially enthusiastic about the updated strategies for guiding participants through the world of sustainable fashion.

### Next Steps for Sustainable Fashion Entrepreneurship:

We're focusing on refining our assessments and incorporating innovative teaching methods, which helps foster creative thinking and problem-solving. Next we are going to incorporate the feedback from our participants and trainers to ensure they're equipped with the best possible resources.
