

Job Description: Access Arts K-8th Schools Out Teacher

This position is temporary and seasonal. There are 13 Schools Out days total for the 2023-2024 school year. Applicants ideally will be able to teach all 13 days of Schools Out, though we will entertain applicants who are available for fewer days. An additional week of teaching during our Spring Break camp is also an option.

There are six K-8th Schools Out Teacher positions:

- We are in need of 4 K-3rd teachers for all 13 days of Schools Out: Two will teach the morning shift (M-F, 7:30-12:30) and two will teach the afternoon shift (M-F, 12:30-5:30).
- We are in need of 2 4th-8th teachers for all 13 days of Schools Out: Two will teach the morning shift (M-F, 7:30-12:30) and two will teach the afternoon shift (M-F, 12:30-5:30)

Desired Qualifications

- College degree strongly preferred; Art or Art Education Degree a plus
- Teaching experience in School or Camp setting required
- Experience with Community Arts and Crafts/Ceramics programs is a plus
- Experience working with students with adaptive needs is a plus
- High energy, enthusiastic, creative person with a great spirit
- Adaptability, enthusiasm, sense of humor, patience, and self-control

General Responsibilities: To ensure campers have a fun and safe learning experience while instilling a love of art and respect for others.

Specific Responsibilities:

- Create & facilitate age- and skill-appropriate visual art projects for students within a mixed-level classroom (children ages 5-8 or 9-13)
- Supervise all aspects of the campers' day, including, but not limited to art-making, gardening activities, lunch & snacks, and recess
- Coordinate with other teachers to manage and organize the classroom & art supplies
- Plan art projects in keeping with weekly camp themes and assist in ordering supplies
- Help provide an atmosphere for developing good morale and well-being among the camp attendees; correct misbehavior and redirect as needed

- Maintain good public relations with campers' parents during check-in and check-out

Compensation:

Teachers shall be compensated a flat fee of \$75 for each 5 hour shift. No withholdings will be made, and the individual will receive a 1099 form in January 2024 for tax filing purposes.
