Job Description: Access Arts K-5th Schools Out Lead Teacher

This position is temporary and seasonal. There are 13 Schools Out days total for the 2024-2025 school year. Applicants ideally will be able to teach all 13 days of Schools Out, though we will entertain applicants who are available for fewer days. An additional week of teaching during our Spring Break camp is also an option.

We have multiple positions open for morning and afternoon. Each shift is 5.5 hours with an hour of overlap to accommodate some prep/cleanup time mid-day. Teachers work 7:30am-1:00pm or 12:00pm-5:30pm.

Students are usually split into K-2nd and 3rd-5th grade. You will be assigned to one classroom and work with that group of students for the duration of your shift.

The lead teacher is responsible for lesson planning, classroom management, and facilitating daily routines for a class of approximately 15 campers at a time. Students will range in age and abilities in the same classroom setting. Lead teachers should plan to teach 2-3+ projects per shift to a diverse group of learners.

 \cdot Supervise all aspects of the campers' day, including, but not limited to art-making, gardening activities, lunch & snacks, and recess

- · Plan art projects in keeping with weekly camp themes and assist in ordering supplies
