



Martha Gonzales Rose

Named for Martha Gonzales, who found this classic old-fashioned rose growing in her garden in Navasota, Texas, in 1984. 'Martha Gonzalez' is incredibly carefree, and too much maintenance misses the point. Many gardeners use this shrub as a low border.

Zones: 7-11 Mature size: 3ftH X 3ftW

Water: Low to Moderate Sun: Full sun to part shade

Flowers: Red Bloom Time: Apr-Nov

Esperanza (Tacoma stans)

Tecoma stans is native to parts of south Texas, west Texas and central Texas. Esperanza is a great drought tolerant plant. It likes well-drained soils and needs little water once established. It can handle the extreme heat of Texas summers, and is often one of the few plants blooming in landscapes during July and August!

Zone: 8-11 Mature size: 3-6ftH X 2-4ftW

Water: Low once established Sun: Full sun

Flowers: Yellow trumpet Bloom time: June-Sep





Desert Willow (*Chilopsis linearis*)

Native to Southwestern US and Mexico, this deciduous, drought-tolerant shrub is a favorite among pollinators and birds.

Zones: 6-9

Mature size: 12'-18' H x W

Water: Low to Moderate

Light: Full to part sun

Flowers: pink/purple

Bloom Time: May to June

Chaste Tree (*Vitex Agnus-Castus*)

Known as a fragrant, showy large shrub, Vitex offers vibrant color to any landscape. Often used in a border or as a small tree accent.

Zones: 6-9

Mature size: 8-10'H x 5-8'W

Water: Low to Moderate

Light: Full to part sun

Flowers: violet/blue

Bloom Time: June to August





Anacacho Orchid Tree (*Bauhinia lunarioides*)

A stunning small tree native to Texas and Mexico, the Anacacho boasts white orchid-like blooms from late winter to early summer.

Zone: 8-10

Mature size: 8-12'H x 6-12'W

Water: Low to Moderate

Light: Full sun to part shade

Flowers: white to pale pink

Bloom Time: March to May

Yaupon Holly, Pride of Houston (*Ilex Vomitoria*)

Makes a great landscape accent plant with its graceful, upright form; bright red berries that persist into the winter and attract birds; does best in evenly moist, acidic soil but is drought tolerant.

Zone: 7a-9b

Mature size: 15-20ftH X 10-15ftW

Water: Low to Moderate

Light: Full sun to part shade

Flowers: Yellow/White

Deer resistant: Yes





Texas Mountain Laurel (*Dermatophyllum secundiflorum*)

Texas mountain laurel is a tough evergreen shrub or small tree native to Mexico and the American Southwest. It is known for its attractive, fragrant flowers and its extreme drought hardiness. Native to the Chihuahuan Desert.

Zone: 7b-10 Mature size: 10-15ftH X 8-10ftW

Water: Low Light: Full sun to light shade

Flowers: purple grape clusters Growth rate: Slow



Prairie Flame-Leaf Sumac (*Rhus lanceolata*)

A fast growing small tree, Prairie Sumac is a central Texas native. Heat, cold, and drought-tolerant, this tree boasts brilliant red foliage in the fall.

Zone: 7-9 Mature size: 30ftH X 20ftW

Water: Low to Moderate Light: Full sun to part shade

Flowers: Yellow clusters in Summer

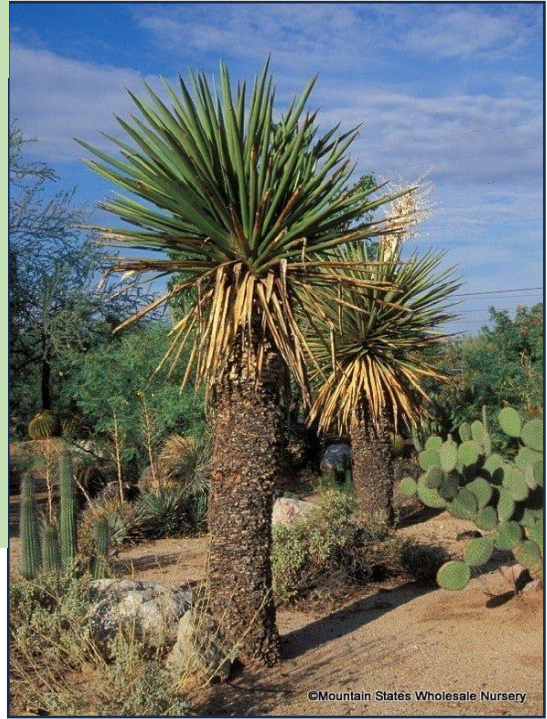
Faxon Yucca (*Yucca faxoniana*)

Commonly known as Faxon Yucca or Giant Dagger Yucca, this tree-like plant is native to the desert regions of the southwestern United States and northern Mexico.

Zone: 7-11 Mature size: up to 20ftH X 6ftW

Water: Very low Light: Full Sun

Flowers: White flower stalks up to 7ft

Thompson Yucca (*Yucca thompsoniana*)

This yucca is native to limestone hills, rocky slopes and plains in southwestern Texas, southeastern New Mexico, and parts of northern Mexico.

Zone: 7-11 Mature size: 8-10ftH X 4ftW

Water: Very low Light: Full sun

Flowers: White/cream flower stalks

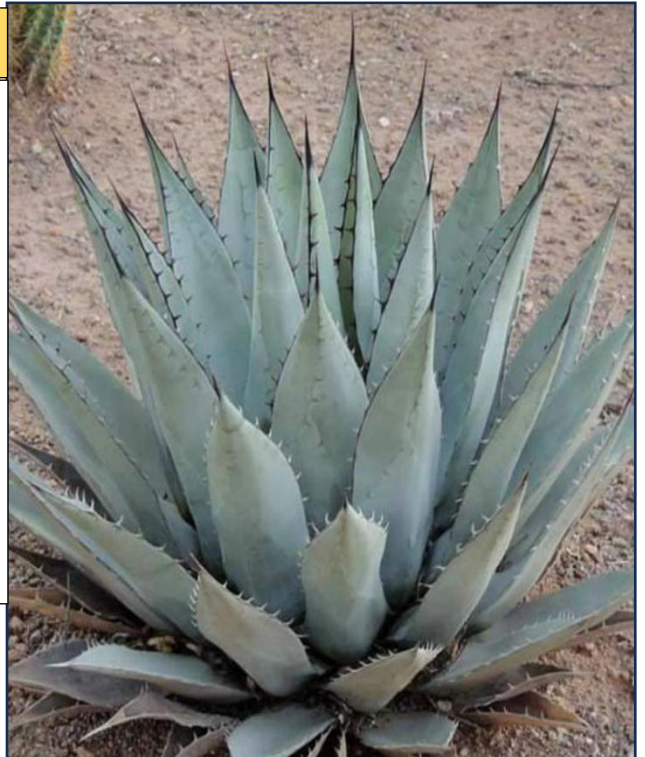

Agave NeoMexicana (Agave Parryi v.)

This variety is native to southeastern New Mexico and west Texas, growing on rocky limestone slopes from 1400 to 7000 feet in elevation. In low deserts, plant it in part sun and provide good drainage. It can handle full sun exposures at higher elevations. This agave will need some additional moisture in heat of summer.

Zone: 5 (-20 F) Mature Size: 2ft H X 2ft W



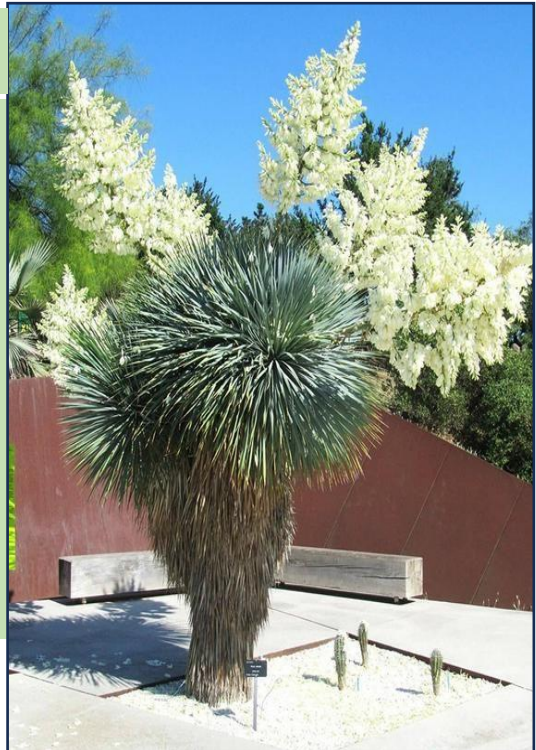
Beaked Yucca (Yucca rostrata)

From the family of Asparagaceae, Beaked Yucca is extremely tolerant to heat, drought, and frost. It can withstand temperatures as low as -10° degrees Fahrenheit. It offers a striking focal point in gravel gardens, Mediterranean gardens, and borders.

Zone: 5-11 Mature size: 6-15ftH X 4-10ftW

Water: Very low Light: Full sun

Flowers: White stalks in spring

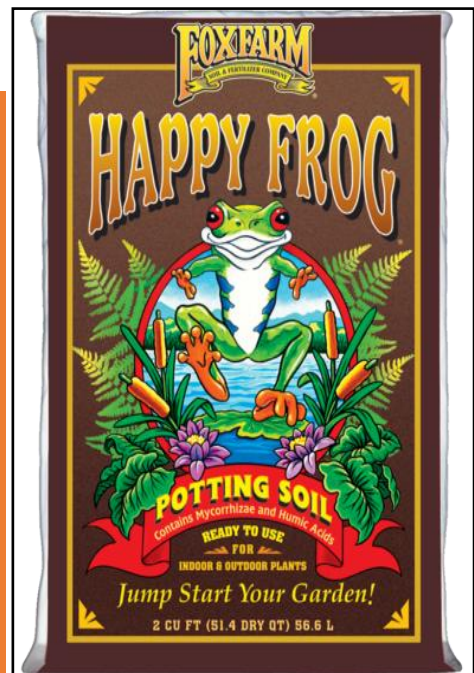
