Sevaluation and Reporting

- The national administrative departments will evaluate the implementation of adopted international standards and submit any issues regarding these standards for revision to the appropriate international standardization bodies.
- Monitor and report on international standards progress within 30 days of each development stage.

${\mathscr P}$ Adoption and Prioritization

- Prioritize projects to adopt international standards, with a 12-month deadline for approval drafts.
- Applicable international standards are issued by ISO, IEC, and ITU, which can be adopted as is or modified for China national standards.

© Copyright Protection

– Emphasize copyright protection throughout project evaluation, approval, and public release of standards with Chinese laws and regulations as well as international standardization regulations
