UNDERSTANDING COMPLEXITY: POLICY TOOLS THAT PROPEL GOVERNMENT GOALS **Policy Instruments**

• Regulatory Instruments

- Laws, regulations, fines, mandates etc.
- Instruments establish rules & penalties to enforce compliance

• Financial Instruments

- Tax breaks, subsidies, grants, financial incentives etc.
- Instruments provide incentives and rewards to motivate compliance through positive reinforcement

Informational Instruments

- Education and awareness campaigns, advisory etc.
- Instruments aim to educate and influence behavior through awareness and knowledge

Licensing

Foreign OEMS previously needed 50:50 JVs with Chinese companies to operate in China. In 2018, this requirement for EVs was lifted, enabling Tesla to open its wholly owned Gigafactory in Shanghai.

Financing

Tesla received significant support from the Shanghai government for its Gigafactory 3, including land use rights, tax incentives, and a lowinterest loan from Chinese banks to fund construction, reportedly backed by the Shanghai Government.

R&D & Production

Accelerated land use and construction approvals. Access to local supply chains and skilled labor. Favorable NEV policies aligned with China's Made in China 2025 strategy.

Autonomous Driving

Hefei has established itself as a national pilot zone for ICVs, supported by favorable policies and licensing.



Advisory Services

Advisory services from foreign entities are restricted at stateowned entities.

However, if there is alignment on objectives, clear accountabilities, commitment, and responsibilities, project restrictions can be lifted.



• Europe could evolve from rigid frameworks to responsiveness

Policies could be designed not as fixed structures, but as frameworks that breathe, bend, and evolve with the world they aim to shape (common evidence based policy-making needs an upgrade)

• Standardization is a shared language — not a contest

By laying stones together, Europe & China can build pathways of mutual understanding, where shared standards become the scaffolding of future innovation, foster interoperability and mutual progress
