Myles Delfin is the founder of Bike Scouts, the first true Filipino-led social platform for social teamwork or "Bayanihan" (A Filipino word that means "people helping each other solve local challenges in their own community) that helps people become movers of true community-based resilience using bicycles, people power, and community-made technology.

Through its platform, Bike Scouts also serves as a network of support in addressing the climate-change-driven impact of disasters by serving as the only continuously-operational Volunteer Bicycle Messenger service for disaster response in the world.

Bike Scouts is the 2021 finalist for the global Prudence Foundation Safesteps Disaster Tech Awards and among the 1% selected worldwide for participation in the 2021 Facebook Community Accelerator Program. In 2024, The Bike Scouts project and community was nominated for The Earth Shot Prize.

Myles worked previously as a Creative Director in the design and advertising industry handling both local and multi-national brands and businesses in addition to being a contributing writer and photographer for various print and online publications. Myles was also a climber, adventure racing team captain, and competitive cross-country mountain bike racer sponsored by brands such as Adidas, Salomon, and others.
