ADMISSIONS

1. Candidates seeking admission can register their names by remitting a sum of Rs. 150/- (One Hundred and fifty only) which includes the cost of application and prospectus.
2. The completed application forms should be submitted in the office within 10 days from the issue of application form along with the following certificates.
 - a. **Date of Birth Certificate / Parents' Declaration.**
 - b. **Community Certificate if applicable.**
 - c. **Transfer Certificate for the admission of Std. U.K.G. to XII**

AGE LIMIT

K.G. Classes :

At the time of admission of L.K.G. the children must have completed the age of 3 years as on 31st July of the same year. For admission to U.K.G. the child must have completed the age of 4 years as on 31st July of the same year. Admission to other classes should be in the same order.

CO - CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Students must take active part in Intramural & Inter school competitions, games, dance, art, debate, quiz and other cultural activities, which are essential activities of the school.

KARATE, BHARATHANAATIYAM, YOGA, SILAMBAM & OTHERS

Karate, Bharathanaatiyam, Yoga classes will be conducted weekly twice for interested students. Silambam for willing and eligible students in VI, VII & VIII and Yoga for III, IV & V Students will be taught. If parents are interested a very effective female self-defence coaching can also be started.

HIGHER SECONDARY ADMISSIONS

1. Candidates seeking admission can register their names by remitting a sum of Rs. 200/- (Two Hundred only) which includes the cost of application and prospectus.
2. The completed application forms should be submitted in the office within 5 days from the issue of application form along with the following certificates.
 - a. Transfer Certificate
 - b. Conduct Certificate
 - c. Mark sheet of the last Exam passed.
3. The marks of the previous examinations will be taken into consideration for the admission. The deserving candidates will be given provisional admission. The selection of the group of subjects will be considered according to the marks of the previous examination and choice of the candidates. The selection will be intimated through a Recorded Phone Call. The candidates should pay the school fees in full on the same date of admission failing which the admission will be cancelled and the seat will be given to the next deserving candidate.

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE SCHOOL

1. School fees should be paid in three Terms namely, I - Term at admission time II - Term by the end of October III - Term by the end of January. Fees once paid will not be refunded or adjusted to any other student on any account.
2. The students should be present inside the school 15 minutes before the school prayer. Late comers will not be allowed inside the school.
3. The Uniform is compulsory on all school days. The students who fail to wear uniform will not be allowed to attend the class. Parents/Guardians will be asked to bring the uniform to school to change.
4. The Medium of instruction is English. Hence the students must converse only in English..
5. Students must obey the School Authorities and Staff. Strict Discipline should be followed inside and outside of the school.
6. The School Authorities have full powers to deal legally if any students creates trouble to other students or staff, inside and outside the school premises. The students making nuisance in the public will be handed over to the Law and Order Enforcing Authorities.
7. The parents and guardians of L.K.G and U.K.G. students will be permitted to feed their children inside the school for 45 working days only, from the date of school reopening. There after the students must take their mid day meal by their own.
8. Parents should not allow their children to wear gold or costly ornaments during school hours. School cannot be held responsible in case of loss.
9. No student will be allowed to go out for mid day meal.
10. The School activities will be decided in consultation with the Parents/ Guardian in the Parent-Teachers meeting. Unnecessary individual involvement of the Parents or Guardian will not be allowed.
11. The Parents / Guardians will be allowed to meet the Teachers / Principal / Correspondent on appointment only. Parents must get appointment from the school office in person or by phone giving reason to meet.
12. If there is any change in the phone number, Parents must inform the school immediately.

13. If any I.D. card is lost, parents should inform the school authorities IMMEDIATELY for security reasons.
14. The students should not bring cell phones to the school. If any student brings the cell phone, it should be handed over to the office staff and can be taken back after the school hours. If any student fails to do so, it will be confiscated and destroyed at once.
15. Parents should check school diary everyday and sign.
16. Parents should give more importance to any call from the school regarding Progress Report and Parents meeting.
17. Students must keep all the books and notebooks well wrapped and neatly maintained.
18. Two extra periods are compulsory for X, XI & XII Students.
19. Students can take leave only on prior sanction. Leave letter is a must.
20. The Parents / Guardians can give their opinion through the COMPLAINT / SUGGESTION BOX which is kept near the Gate.
21. TRANSPORT: There is no transportation facility in the school. Private vans are available. The parents can avail these private service. The van operators are solely responsible for the safety and security of the students. The school has no liability at all.
22. In case of doubts and conflicts, the decision of the School Management will be the final.

EXAMINATIONS

The School has three Terminal Examinations namely Quarterly, Half-yearly and Annual. Apart from the Mid-Term Exams, Monthly tests, Unit tests are conducted. Progress report is maintained PARENT - TEACHER MEETINGS are conducted every term and whenever necessary. All must attend. This provides ample opportunity for Parent-Teacher Co-operation in the interest of Students. There will be no special exam for the absentees. Any attempt of malpractice will be viewed seriously.
