

The final frame schedule (with the exact planned conclusion of all matches) shall be made at least 20 days before the start of the tournament and shall be published on the organizer's website. The tournament system will be K.O. system, according to the Laws of Badminton and Competition Regulations of the BWF.

The presentation to all winners and runners up will take place at the prize giving ceremony following the conclusion of the relevant final. Only winner and runner up must be present at the prize giving ceremony. Players are reminded when booking flights home on Sunday that the finals may not finish until 5:00 pm, depending on the start time and also that they may be selected for doping testing they should therefore book their flights accordingly.

Entry fees in cash: Entry fees can also be paid in cash at the tournament venue before

the first scheduled match. The Member that enters a player/pair into a BEC Junior Circuit tournament is responsible for paying the entry fees for that player/pair. The entry fees become due if a player is entered and has not been withdrawn when the entry deadline passes. The entry fees will not be refunded in the case of a withdrawal. For all the withdrawn players the organizers can invoice

the entry fee to the relevant Member

Prize money: There is no prize money for this tournament.

Prizes: Medals and prizes for the winners, medals for finalists and semi-

finalists in each event during price giving ceremony after the Finals.

Courts: 4-5 courts YONEX, depending on number of entries

Entries: Men's (MS) and women's (WS) single, men's (MD) and women's

(WD) double and mixed doubles (XD). According to BWF rules, players born in 2007 or later can be accepted. The maximum number of competitors accepted in the tournament are: 48 players in men's and women's singles / 32 pairs in men's and women's doubles, in mixed doubles. All events will be played in KO system. No qualifications will be played before the main draw. In accordance with regulations § 9.2 and § 9.3 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.2: World Junior Ranking System, an event must contain at least 8 (eight) competitors in the first published version of the main draw. If the required number of competitors is not met in the first published version of the main draw, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking. In accordance with regulation § 9.4 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.2: World Junior Ranking System, an event must contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member in the first published version of the main draw. If an event does not contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member in the first published version of the main draw, this particular event shall not count

towards any ranking.

















Badminton Europe is not liable for any costs incurred by third persons (players, coaches, umpires, team managers etc.) because of an event not having enough competitors to count for the rankings.

All entries must be made by using the BWF Online Entry System. Entries must be submitted no later than 30th of September 2025 at 23.59 BWF HQ time (GMT +08.00) All participants need to have the BWF ID.

No late entries will be accepted. Players cannot be entered unless they already have a BWF ID number. In case you wish to enter players who do not have a BWF ID number, please contact the BWF office well in advance of the tournament, so that the players concerned can get a BWF ID number before the closing date of the tournament.

Compliance with General Competition Regulations Clause 7.9: GCR 7.9: "In making or authorizing entries, the Member concerned is reconfirming its acceptance, and acceptance by the Players being entered, of the BWF's regulations and Disciplinary processes."

Clothing/Advertising:

Color, design, lettering and advertising on clothing shall be regulated by BWF Statutes, Section 5.2.3: Junior Tournament Regulations § 12 to 16.

13.1 Color, design, lettering and advertising on clothing shall be regulated by BWF Statutes, Section 5.2.3: Junior Tournament Regulations § 12 to 16. A player violating these regulations shall be penalized by an administrative fine of 50,00 EUR. 13.2 It is mandatory for the semi-finals and finals that partners in doubles wear the same color of the T-shirt and shorts/skirts. Failing to do so shall result in an administrative fine of 50,00 EUR.

Condition of play:

The tournament will be played in full accordance with the laws of Badminton and General Competition Regulations adopted by the BWF as well as the regulations of the BWF Junior Tournaments and Badminton Europe Junior Circuit Regulations.

Competitors must be prepared to play at the times quoted in the

order of play for the events for which they were entered.

Competitors can be scratched if not ready to play when called.

Badminton Integrity:

Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code on The Prevention of The Manipulation of Competitions) relates to anticorruption and anti-

















match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.

To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, respect the principle of fair play, and should not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.

Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of matches.

Doping control:

Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples. Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).

The Organizers decline responsibility and covering costs for possible injuries or other damages. It is up to participants to insure themselves.

Badminton Europe is not liable for any such claims, actions, damages, costs or expenses of any nature whatsoever, including but not limited to injury or loss to a person or property, arising out of or in any way related, directly or indirectly, to the particular BEC Junior Circuit tournament. It is recommended that Members and/or Organizers purchase a proper Insurance Policy that would cover their potential legal liability.

Imaging permissions:

When a player is entered in a BWF-sanctioned event, television/broadcasting and still photography of that event are permitted at all associated venues (including training/ practice) without further need to seek the consent of the player or Member concerned. Television signals can be shown in any and all territories on live or recorded television, Internet, web casting, audio, film and other media of similar nature.















Stringing: Stringing service will be available during the tournament, the price

for stringing will be 15 EUR with own strings and 20 EUR with

bought strings.

Medical: A first aid nurse will be present in the Sports hall during the

tournament and a medical doctor will be on call.

Cancelation of the tournament:

The organizing Member can cancel a tournament in case of *force majeure* or due to too few entries in at least one of the events. Such cancellation must be announced at least 15 days before the start of the tournament. If a cancellation is announced less than 15 days before the start of the tournament, then the Member organizing the tournament is liable for any expenses incurred by third person (players, coaches, umpires, team managers etc.). Badminton Europe is not liable for any costs incurred by third persons because of a cancellation of a tournament.
