The sisters have celebrated a milestone this year! Twenty years of living out the Evangelical Counsels and Upholding the Dignity of every human person from the moment of conception until natural death!!

February 2, 1999, on the feast of the Presentation of Our Lord, the religious community of the Franciscan Daughters of Mary was born in the Archdiocese of Newark.

We opened up a crisis pregnancy center, the Rose Garden, where we assisted local moms with making good choices in their pregnancies, their relationships and their lives. We also offered material assistance for whatever their babies needed and food for them and all of their family members whenever it was donated to us.

When we began gaining members, Archbishop John J. Meyers gave us permission to find a convent to move in to, but after searching the archdiocese, we couldn't find one convent that was suitable for our needs.

With the Archbishop's blessing, we wrote to several bishops in the country who we knew to had a heart for pro-life issues. We received a few replies, and through prayer we determined that it was the Lord's Will that we graciously accept Bishop Foy's

offer to move the community to the Diocese of Covington, KY.

On September 15, 2004, with the assistance of about 35 parishioners, we moved in to the convent at St. Benedict's Church in Covington.

Bishop Foys had requested that we open a pregnancy center as we had in New Jersey, because at the time there weren't any fully *Catholic* pregnancy centers in his Diocese. So in October of the following year we opened the Rose Garden Home Mission on Madison Avenue in Covington.

Expecting to mostly work with Moms and babies, we saw the Lord's hand guiding us to feed local families in need because many of the lay faithful kept donating food to our Mission. With this in mind and also because our neighbors had come to rely on us for food, we made a "deal" with God that as long as He kept sending food, we would keep giving it out.

Everything that we have and everything that we give to others is donated to us, we have just always trusted that the Lord would send us what we need when we need it. And, you know, He

is a very faithful provider for His spouses- this small family of sisters.

He inspired us to adopt 3 Scripture verses to follow at the Mission: Mt 5:42, "Give to the one who asks of you," Mt 10:8, "Without cost you have received, without cost you are to give," and Mt 25:36-37, "I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me to drink, a stranger and you welcomed me, naked and you clothed me, ill and you cared for me, in prison and you visited me."

We try to do as many of these as He has presented us with, including beginning Health Ministries in 2009, opening a free medical clinic in 2012, and a free dental clinic in 2017.

The Lord has also inspired two new initiatives: Avow Discernment

Groups, as promoted by Vianney Vocations, for young women discerning God's Will in their lives; and partnering with IHM Saints for Life in Mary's Pro-Life Boot Camp, a respect life retreat-style camp for High School teens to foster leadership among young people to be pro-life witnesses and helping them to engage in "Life" issues in a more active way.

Please pray for us that we continue to faithfully follow God's Will in all things, while Upholding the Dignity of every human person from the moment of conception until natural death.

One night, we got a call from this mom saying that her baby had turned blue and was rushed off to Children's Hospital because her lungs were compromised. No one knew if she was going to live. Her mom wanted the Sisters there, so we rushed to the hospital with some Holy Water and asked if she wanted to Baptize the baby. She agreed and as soon as she was Baptized, Sister noticed a difference in her. She perked up! She is now a healthy, happy little girl!

woman came into the mission the other week looking for Sr. Mary Joseph. She cried when we told her that she passed way. She then shared with us that sister helped her and her now 10 year old son and wanted him to meet her.

"When he was born a distant relative abandoned him at a bus stop. Someone I know told me and I picked him up. It was then that I called the Mission for help. Sr. Mary Joseph was so sweet, she told me to come down right away, even though they were closed and she would help me. This gave me hope that everything was going to be alright. You all gave us a car seat, stroller, pack n' play, clothing and a baby basket! If it wasn't for this place and her kindness, I would have had nothing for him!" This woman raised him like her own. He was born a preemie and was sickly, but today is the picture of health!

ugs abound in the medical clinic! Last month as I unlocked the door, a patient entered and said, "I'm so glad to see you!" and gave me a big hug.

He is the same person who came initially for ear wax removal. We noted his high blood pressure and told him it should be treated. He was against that because he couldn't afford the medicine. We explained our procedure for obtaining prescription medication from a local pharmacy, so he agreed to cooperate.



Coming in on subsequent visits, we addressed his 30+ pack/year history of smoking and obtained a low-density CT scan from St. Elizabeth. He did not have cancer, but took this as a wake-up call and quit smoking.

His scan revealed blockages in his heart arteries, and he was referred to a cardiologist who recommended surgery. But the surgery could not be completed until his infected teeth were extracted and

the remaining teeth cleaned. After several visits to our dental clinic, he was well enough to have his surgery, and now his health is doing very well.

This same gentleman shared with us that he did not qualify for Medicaid because his pension gave him \$3 per month too much. He couldn't afford insurance on his own because it costs too much based on his pension.

"I am very grateful for the free services I was given. Everyone was extremely nice and professional. You can **feel** the ministry behind the services provided, which means a lot!"




