ACCOMMODATION

SELF CATERING COTTAGES

The accommodation is selfcatering, and each chalet comes with its own fully equipped kitchen and bathroom. Towels are provided for your convenience. You will need to bring your meals and snacks with you. Breakfasts and lunches can be enjoyed in vour own accommodation. However, each evening, delegates are welcome to bring their food to the Manor House. where a communal supper can be enjoyed as a group. A fire will be lit every evening for those who would like to braai (barbecue). Please note that the communal supper is optional.

EQUIPMENT

Camera

You will need a DSLR or Mirrorless camera. Your camera must have a multiple exposure function.

Filters

A neutral density filter, either fixed or variable. 3 to 8 stops are recommended.

Lenses

16mm to 200mm, but no more than 400mm focal length is necessary. A macro lens is optional.

Tripod is optional

Computer

A laptop or desktop computer with editing software.

Art Materials

Art supplies are provided, but you are welcome to bring your own if you prefer. You will need: Watercolour paint set Assortment of brushes Watercolour pencils

Printing services will be available at a nominal cost, so there's no need for you to bring your own printer or paper.

Over the past twenty-eight years, my methodology has taken numerous detours while walking a self-discovery path. It is a journey that has refined a relaxed subconscious attitude, with a desire to express simplicity and honesty through my work. For me, a photograph holds an undeniable sense of realism, a new correlation that allows for simple association and connection. I see, I understand; I experience, I connect. In my photography, I allow day-to-day life to provide inspiration and treat all subjects as potential compositions. I enjoy the conceptual transformation that a lens and camera offer. Although I have never been a dedicated painter, I see and experience the world this way.

Life is my canvas, and I often feel like a painter trapped in a photographer's body where lens and light have become an expressive substitute for paint and brushes. I usually create themes and grouping of images within my portfolio and, on a given day, find myself working on various projects at once, often taking years to complete.
