United Cornwall FC are a social football group that meet weekly in locations across Cornwall. Starting in January 2023, we have grown from one session in Camborne, to include weekly games in Newquay and Truro. Our sessions are mixed gender, age and ability, and we have created a welcoming space for individuals to meet weekly. Whether players come to lose weight, improve mental health or just meet others doesn't matter to us.

Our Impact

We gather regular informal feedback from our players, alongside bi-annual player surveys. This allows us to adapt our sessions but also understand and showcase our impact.

Over 90% of players state that getting involved with UCFC sessions improves their wellbeing.



70% of players state that through attending sessions they feel more connected to their community



United Cornwall FC has seen over **200 players** attend in **70 sessions**, across **3 locations** in 2023.



100% of our players support our Pay as You Can scheme. This allows our players to support us when they are doing well, but still engage if times are tough.







Our Numbers

We log attendance of our sessions, so we can review our growth and understand the importance of our sessions for those involved. Players also receive a UCFC T-shirt once they make it to 25 appearances.

We run **3** weekly sessions in Truro, Camborne and Newquay. With another in Truro starting early in 2024.

Camborne (started January 2023) - 1050 social footballing experiences created

Newquay (started July 2023) - 284 social footballing experiences created

Truro (started October 2023) - 90 social footballing experiences

Total - **1424** footballing experiences in 2023

Session Leads

In 2023 we have trained and supported a team of 4 Session Leads. This has increased our capacity, whilst also allowing us to react to illness and cancellations. Each Session Lead has received:

- Inhouse UCFC Training, which includes Safeguarding and Policy and Procedure information.
- Suitable First Aid Qualification
- Ongoing support from UCFC Management
- Opportunity to access additional training as needed
- PPE and equipment
- Socials and catch ups

Each session will have a Location Lead, with a group of Session Leads who are able to step in when needed. This scheme is vital to our ongoing sustainability, resilience and success.
