Praise the Lord, Jesus has been truly good in the ministry that has just begun. The ministry in Hiliana'a Village has now been running for two months. Since it first started, the number of children enrolling has continued to grow—from only 5 children at the beginning to now 18 children who are attending the tutoring/learning program in Hiliana'a.

We see that the children here are in great need of education. Some children, even at the age of five, still cannot read or write, and some as young as four cannot yet hold a pen properly. There are also children already in the fifth grade of elementary school who are still struggling to read fluently.

With the presence of this tutoring program in Hiliana'a, the children have been greatly helped in their education. We believe this ministry is becoming a great blessing for them.
