Administration and Online Registration Key Dates

- Online Registration Opens: Thursday 12th February 2026
- Registration Closing Date: Sunday 24th May 2026 (Sunday 31st May 2026 for Team Managers)

GMS

- Reactivation emails will be sent to individuals who attended BTG 2025
- New athletes will need to complete a new registration online
- Athletes formerly in a Children's team that have/will turn 18 before the 30th June 2026 cut-off will need to begin a new registration unless they intend to remain in the Children's team and compete in adult age categories

Medical

- As for the 2025 Games, Competitors from the British Isles are not required to complete a medical form unless they are on dialysis. They are instead required to sign a medical waiver within the GMS.
- All international athletes are still required to submit a completed Medical Form for approval to compete in the Games.

Invoicing & Payments

- Complete and return your Team Manager Contact Details Form & Invoicing.
 - Team Invoice or Individual Invoice – you can't select both options.
 - Team Invoice
 - Invoices will be run in surname order
 - Payment to be made within 7 days of receiving the invoice






