SPINS BOWL CARMEL YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP BOWLING TOURNAMENT RULES

This Tournament is open to all USBC certified youth bowlers participating in a certified league (including the High School Bowling programs). All youth bowlers participating in this Tournament must present their USBC certification card, or a receipt of payment of certification fees, at check-in which begins 1 hour before Tournament start time. Walk-ins will be accepted if space is available. Bowlers not ready to bowl at the start of the Tournament will not be permitted to compete. Participants bowling in an adult bowling league will not be allowed to participate in this event. All bowlers must be checked in at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the Tournament.

Tournament Format: Youth will bowl 3 games on a pair of lanes. The top 3 positions based on total pins, including handicap in the Handicap Division, will bowl a single-game elimination stepladder final. Ties for 1st or 3rd position will be broken by a 9th and 10th frame roll-off. If a tie still exists, another 9th and 10th frame roll-off will determine the standings. The top three Elite Division bowlers will also compete in a single game elimination stepladder final. One of every 6 bowlers in each division will receive scholarship points.

Participants can bowl in the Handicap or Scratch Division. Handicap will be 100% of the difference between the bowler's entering average and 220. There will be no maximum handicap for a participant and handicap will be used for the qualifying rounds and the stepladder finals in the Handicap Division. There will be no handicap in the Elite Scratch Division.

Bowlers will use their current USBC certified league average with a minimum of 12 games. Bowlers must present a current league sheet as proof of average at the tournament. If a bowler's average cannot be verified, or no average exists using the above criteria, the bowler will receive "0" handicap.

This Tournament is for scholarship competition points only. Entry fee will be \$30.00 if paid by December 21, 2025. After December 21, 2025, the entry fee will be \$35.00. Bowlers who have pre-paid must bring their payment receipt to check-in as well as their certification card. The entry fee will be divided as follows:

Bowling \$15.00 Scholarship Contribution \$12.00 Expenses \$3.00 Total \$30.00

The additional \$5.00 fee for entries received after December 21, 2025, will be added to the Scholarship Fund. Entry fee can be paid by check, cash, MasterCard or Visa. Checks should be made out to Spins Bowl Carmel with "Spins Bowl Carmel Youth Tournament" on the memo line and can be mailed to Spins Bowl Carmel, 23 Old Route 6, Carmel, NY 10512. Mailed entries will be accepted through December 21, 2025.

Bowlers will bowl in one of the following divisions: Boys & Girls age 10 & under, Boys age 11-14, Boys age 15 & older, Girls age 11-14, Girls age 15 and over, Boys or Girls Elite Scratch Division age 15 and older, Boys & Girls Elite Scratch Division age 14 and under. Age of participants is based on actual age as of January 7, 2026.

\$700.00 in Scholarship contributions will be donated for this Tournament by Spins Bowl Carmel. Distribution points will be determined on the basis of participation. Points for performance will be awarded for bowling ability. In addition, the top finalist, 2nd and 3rd place in each division will receive medals. This is a points-based event. There are no specific dollars for placement. One of every 6 bowlers in each division will receive scholarship points.

Only bowlers, designated scorekeepers, and Tournament Officials are allowed in the bowler's area during the Tournament. If a problem arises, all bowlers on the pair of lanes in question are to stop bowling and IMMEDIATELY call a Tournament Official. All score corrections and problems require a Tournament Official to be present. Chairs and tables closest to the lanes belong to the bowling athletes.

A code of conduct will be posted for parents and bowlers to abide by. Failure to follow this code can be grounds for disqualification of the bowler from the Tournament.

Proper attire is required for participation in the Tournament. Jeans and tee-shirts (no offensive language permitted) are permitted. Baggy pants, jeans with holes, hats and short skirts are not permitted. In addition, no earbuds, I-Pods, MP3's, cell phones, or gaming are permitted during bowling.

Qualification for a potential scholarship is based upon the following items: Cumulative GPA at graduation, ACT/SAT scores, bowling achievement, and community service. A student must apply to the New York Scholarship Committee providing the proper submitted documents. Once the committee has reviewed the qualifying criteria, a scholarship may be awarded.
