JULY MEETING MINUTES

Tom Dearden started the meeting on 7/8/2011 at 6:10pm at the flying field with 12 members present and no visitors. Rich Brown was voted in as a returning member.

Minutes from the previous meeting were accepted as printed in the June newsletter.

Treasurer's Report – The treasurer's report showed a balance of either \$1599.50 or \$1629.50 since there was a discrepancy in the checking account between the books and the bank statement. This will be worked out and the updated amount reported next month.

Safety report – In the XFC, the aircraft fly close to the spectators, but flying toward them is always avoided. Additionally the flight line is strictly enforced. These are items that should be used at our field as well as they both reduce the risk of injury to onlookers.

Web report – Mitch has made some updates to the website & is awaiting the latest roster for posting.

Board report – The report was given by Peter which covered:

- Membership cards should be given out when members are voted in. Dave made up cards for this year & handed them out to those present. Cards for members not present will be mailed.

Treasurer's Report – After finding the error from the previous month, the treasurer's report now shows a balance of 1869.24 in the checking account. Proceeds from the fly-in netted the club \$238.65

Safety report – There was much discussion as a result of the accident during the fly-in. These are some of the highlights:

- The safety officer should have very few other duties as his primary responsibility is to monitor the activities.
- There should be two spotters on the flight line at all times during events.
- The flight lines do not align with AMA specifications.
- As a Contest Director, Mick discussed the role of a CD during events.

These tips will be reviewed for all future events.

Board report – The report was given by Peter which covered:

- The fly-in incident was already covered.
- The audit by the Board of the club records will be done this month. Mike M. has been assigned to review them and present his findings at the September Board meeting.
- Tom should now have all new member applications.

Also, the grass cutting schedule has been updated by Rich H. for the rest of the season, but it hadn't yet been updated on the web – Note: The calendar on the web site has now been updated to reflect the rest of the mowing schedule.
