APRIL MEETING MINUTES

 - Other parks would accept us, but because these would be outside of our area, there was no interest

New Business:

 - May 3rd
 - We can do a static display, however, it may be outside. Peter will be checking on this which will determine if we participate
 - Flying might be possible
 - AMA insurance will be needed if we fly
 - A motion was made for Mike to get insurance if we are going to be there – motion passed
 - More information will be discussed about this event at the May meeting, however, since the meeting date is so close to the event date, there will be very little time to get more information out. If anyone is interested, it would be best that they show up to the meeting.
- Field opening will be discussed at the May meeting
