MEETING MINUTES

Mike Massey started the meeting on 3/7/2016 at 6:03pm at the library with 8 members present and Julian McClellon as a visitor.

Minutes from the previous meeting were accepted as printed in the newsletter.

Treasurer's Report – We have \$2181.97 in the checking account.

Safety report – Nothing to report.

Web report – All is well

Board report – None this month.

Old Business:

- Mike will be registered with the FAA before outdoor flying begins. His name will be used in the club's aircraft for identification.
- Indoor fly-ins are going well. The owner received lots of appreciation from the spectators and pilots for allowing us to be there.
- The club charter is ready to be sent in. James Clements (3CM) isn't going to be insured until later. All club officers have their AMA up to date.
- Memorial Day and Labor Day picnics have been voted on and approved for this year.

Tabled Items:

- An expansion to the storage shed, changing it from an 8'x8' to an 8'x16' with an 8'x16' pavilion (essentially a 16'x16' structure). The cost of such a change was calculated to be approximately \$1200. At this point this will be tabled pending more information as well as additional funds. At this point the membership size may not warrant this project. The grant for this has been submitted to the AMA and we've received \$141.90 to be used for field upgrades.
- A future site for winter indoor flying is still being discussed, Zion church was looked at, but won't work out. Peter is still looking.
- Safety nets need to be repaired and the Memorial Day picnic didn't work out as a day to work on them. Currently this is no longer a priority.

New Business:

- The Toledo show is scheduled for 4-2
- IAC (International Aerobatics Competition) will be held at James Clements (3CM) this summer on July 9th and 10th.
- The mowing schedule will be put together by Peter for this summer.
- The opening date for the field was tabled until next meeting.

Airplane Contest:

- This month's airplane was the De Havilland Chipmunk. Wayne was the lucky winner.
