Old Business:

- Indoor flying
 - As of the meeting, the February indoor fun fly has not taken place yet, so we remain \$730.75 in the red and had 42 paid pilots present at the January Fly-In
 - The January fun fly was the first event we broke even due to an anonymous donation of \$375
 - Eric brought up concerns about larger drones at the indoor fun fly. Wayne will make an announcement at the next pilots meeting concerning safety, pointing out Eric as the safety officer and reminding all pilots that any member of the Flying Eagles will be policing the event and ground anyone that is deemed a risk to persons or property.
 - Tri City Sports Complex is now sponsoring a drop in fun fly every Wednesday from 1-4pm through the rest of the indoor season.

New Business:

- Discussion began on installing a permanent sign by the road at the field. Dave Appold has given initial approval, Peter and Mike Massey are going to look into the necessary regulations and permits. More information will be brought to the March meeting for further discussion.

- Eric and Mike Massey correctly identified the airplane as Tacit Blue and Mike is the big winner this month!
