Minutes from the previous meeting were accepted as printed in the December newsletter.

Treasurer's Report – The treasurer's report showed a balance of \$1,144.05 in the checking account.

Safety report – Dave brought up the article that was printed in this month's AMA Insider on the AMA website. Some of the lessons learned were to be sure that your name & address are attached to the inside of your aircraft, also be sure to verify that all of your control surfaces function "before" taking off and learn what the "left thumb" is used for as this could save your aircraft.

Web report – The roster is now up-to-date with the latest information. A video photo album has been posted of the James Clements event last summer. If anyone takes pictures of any event, please get them to Bob so that he can put them together to be posted to the web. Additionally, club members can post their own pictures directly to the website using the upload function.

Board report – The report was given by Peter which covered:

- Bylaw changes. The following sections will be updated and placed on the web site:
 - Article VIII Section 4 – Wording change for better clarity. Treasurer's records are available to all members, not just officers.
 - Article VIII Section 6 – New section describing the Board's duties.
 - Article X Section 1 – Removed section regarding discounted dues & added section where members joining after August 15th will receive membership for the remainder of the current year plus the following year. Also, a 20% discount will be provided for seniors (65 years of age or over).
 - Article X Section 2 – Wording change for better clarity.
 - Article X Sections 1 & 2 changed the due date from January 1st to the first meeting in January.
 - Article X Section 5 – New section for the changing of passwords, combinations and authorization codes each year.


