NEEDS STATEMENT:

Greenbo County Veterans Accountability Court serves as a vital intervention for veterans struggling with substance use disorders, addressing both the underlying causes of criminal behavior and the barriers to reintegration into the community. Local data reflect the urgency of intervention, with recidivism rates exceeding 50% for those without access to treatment-focused alternatives.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

The program seeks \$150,000 from the U.S. Department of Justice to expand its capacity, enhance treatment services, and strengthen partnerships. Participants receive CBT and Motivational Interviewing, counseling, job placement assistance, and case management. Partnerships with the VA Medical Center and local agencies ensure access to healthcare, housing, and training. Funding will increase treatment slots, workforce training, and add compliance tracking. Expected outcomes: 25% recidivism reduction, 40% treatment completion increase, and improved employment stability for 70% of participants.
