Lewis Capaldi (born on October 7th, 1996) is a singer from Scotland. He was nominated for a special award at the 2019 Brit Awards and won the 2020 Brit Award for Best New Artist. His song "Someone You Loved" was very popular in 2019. It was number one on the UK Singles Chart for seven weeks and also number one on the US Billboard Hot 100. The song was nominated for a Grammy Award and won the 2020 Brit Award for Song of the Year. It was the best-selling song in the UK in 2019 and the longest-running top 10 UK single by a British artist.

He discovered his love for music at a young age and began playing the guitar and writing songs as a teenager. Despite his success, Capaldi has openly shared his struggles with Tourette syndrome, a condition that causes involuntary movements and sounds. He has spoken about how this has affected his life and career but emphasizes that it does not define him. Capaldi's honesty about his condition has inspired many fans who appreciate his music and his openness about his personal challenges.
