











Bio2Watt plants expansion in South Africa, Mozambique and Uganda

Bio2Watt is a waste to value project in South Africa, which will expand to Mozambique and Uganda. Bio2Watt plants treat animal waste and other waste sources to reduce biogas. This creates a biobased energy source, captures and limits methane emissions and reduces the pollution of water resources.

Construction of WASH facilities to empower adolescent girls and women through greater access to inclusive quality education.

Casamance project: upgrade and operation of the port of Ziguinchor in Senegal

Enhance port access, upgrade facilities to meet international secondary port standards, relocate fishery activities to a dedicated port, maintain the access channel (river), and provide technical assistance to port management and staff.

Cleanup of Hann Bay (Dakar) in Senegal

Construction of a wastewater treatment plant and the pre-treatment of the waste from the most polluting industries along the Bay.

Mobilisation of investment and insurance schemes and solutions for climate resilience in Africa.
