



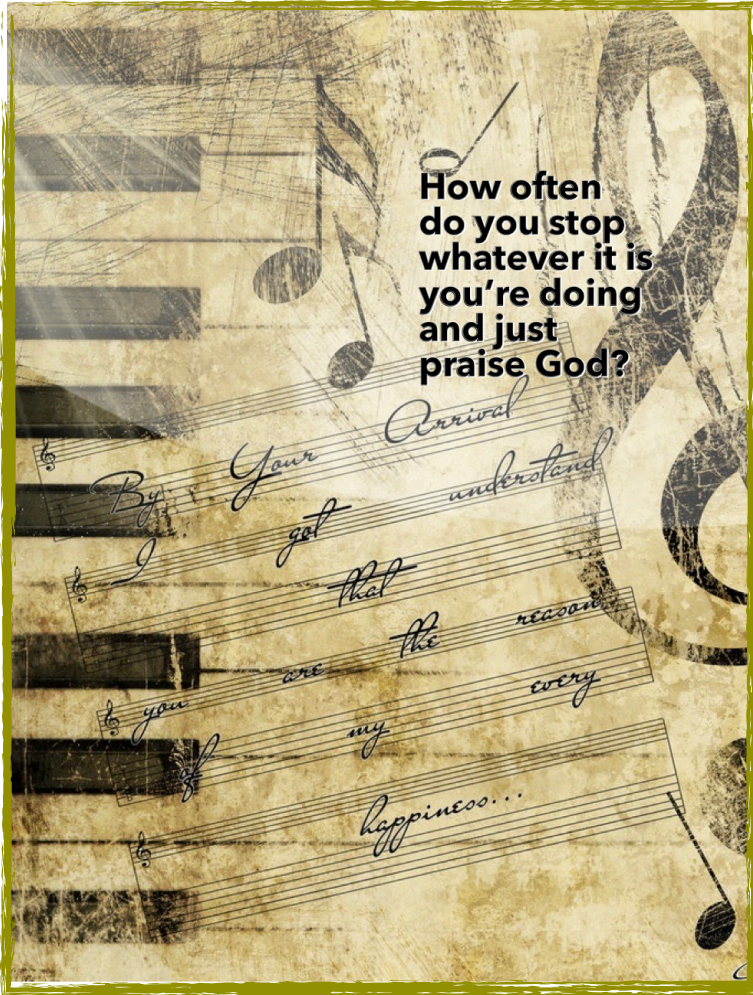

without reservation.

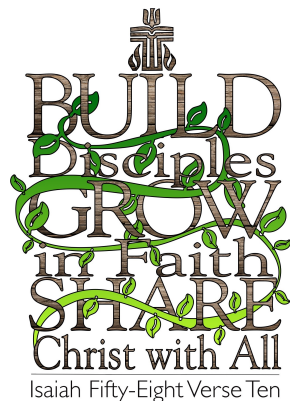
We have reservations,
