

#### **OUR THEME FOR ADVENT 2025**

An expectant mother isn't just a bystander or a passive observer of their pregnancy. Waiting on the child to be born means wellness visits, fulfilling cravings, bones and hormones shifting, nesting, changes in clothing, changes in priorities, changes in habits. Waiting on the child can involve selfreflection, changing relationships, periods of discovery, even illness. And hopefully the community surrounding and supporting the mother to be are going through changes as well. We have traditionally called Mary the theotokos, "God-bearer." And Mary's journey through Advent is instructive for us. As we anticipate what God is going to do, is our waiting passive or active?
