

## READING OF SCRIPTURE

Genesis 1:1-3; Jeremiah 31:1-2; Psalm 118:22-23; John 1:1-5; 20:1-18 (CEB)

In the beginning when God created the heavens and the earth, the earth was a formless void and darkness covered the face of the deep, while a wind from God swept over the face of the waters. Then God said, "Let there be light"; and there was light. At that time, says the LORD, I will be the God of all the families of Israel, and they shall be my people. Thus says the LORD: The people who survived the sword found grace in the wilderness...The stone that the builders rejected has become the chief cornerstone. This is the LORD'S doing; it is marvelous in our eyes. [For] in the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. They didn't yet understand the scripture that Jesus must rise from the dead. Then the disciples returned to the place where they were staying.

Mary stood outside near the tomb, crying. As she cried, she bent down to look into the tomb. She saw two angels dressed in white, seated where the body of Jesus had been, one at the head and one at the foot. The angels asked her, "Woman, why are you crying?"

She replied, "They have taken away my Lord, and I don't know where they've put him." As soon as she had said this, she turned around and saw Jesus standing there, but she didn't know it was Jesus.
