The Lectionary is a world-wide effort to literally get the Church reading from the same page. It is a schedule of readings anchored by the Gospels (Matthew, Mark, Luke and John) and featuring one Old Testament reading, a Psalm, a New Testament reading and a Gospel reading. The readings follow the movements of the timeline of Christ's life. You can look up the schedule for the Revised Common Lectionary for yourself through most search engines.
