BONC WhatsApp Communication Guidelines

1. Purpose

Ensure that information shared within BONC WhatsApp groups is accurate, aligns with our goals and values, for the unity of our community.

2. Objectives

- Effective communication tool.
- Platform to share news, events, and foster collaboration.
- Protect BONC's reputation and maintain a positive image.
- Promote open, respectful, and transparent communication among members.

3. WhatsApp Groups

The following BONC WhatsApp groups are designed to serve specific purposes:

- **The BONC Members:** For the BONC, by the BONC, to the BONC and BONC related
- **BONC Media - The Everything Hub:** A general space for sharing stories, events, congratulations, condolences, and other relevant topics.
- **Announcements:** A platform for the BONC executive team to share important updates and news relevant to the community.
- **Health and Wellbeing Hub:** Dedicated to promoting health and wellbeing resources within the community.
- **Sahaja Yoga Meditation:** Focused on sharing information, schedules and resources related to Sahaja Yoga meditation practices.
- **Table Tennis:** For members interested in table tennis activities and discussions.
- **BONC Musical:** To connect, collaborate and arrange musical sessions.
- **BONC Dance:** To connect, collaborate and arrange dance sessions.

As our community grows, new groups may be introduced to address emerging needs. Updates will be communicated promptly. It is also possible that wider community members in barnet will also benefit from our initiatives.

4. Acceptable Use

To maintain harmony and purpose within the WhatsApp groups, the following guidelines must be adhered to:

- Groups should not be used to air personal grievances or disputes.
- Groups should not be used to spam each other with irrelevant messages
- Groups are not platforms for political discussions or opinions on current affairs.
- Avoid engaging in private conversations within the group; use direct messaging for one-on-one interactions.

- All communication should be respectful, culturally sensitive, and considerate of others.
- Groups and the community platform as a whole must not be used to pursue personal commercial interests. The only exceptions to this shall be through a formal voting process and prior approval.

5. Member Responsibilities

As a member of the BONC WhatsApp groups, you are expected to:

- Respect the ethos, vision, and values of the Burnt Oak Nepalese Community.
- Act in the best interests of the community to promote unity and collaboration.
- Treat all members with respect, fostering a welcoming and inclusive environment.

6. Moderation

Each group will have a moderator responsible for addressing any concerns that arise.

7. Policy Review

This policy will be reviewed annually and updated as needed to reflect the evolving needs of the community.
