Sovereign and definitive rejection of all political, administrative, or symbolic engagement with the United Nations (UN) and the African Union (AU).

 **Official Declaration**

We, the conscious citizens, the servants of the people, and the guardians of Africa's sovereign renaissance, represented by the Digital Republic of Equatorial Guinea™, hereby declare the following:

1. We do not recognize the authority or moral legitimacy of the UN or the AU

as valid institutions capable of representing, mediating, or directing the internal or external affairs of African peoples who have endured centuries of domination, institutional silence, complicity, and systemic repression.

2. We hold that:

- The United Nations has systematically failed to protect Equatorial Guinea from institutional looting, ethical collapse, and political repression.
- The African Union has functioned as an echo chamber for corrupt elites, shielding personal interests at the expense of the rights of African populations.
- Neither organization consulted the people of Equatorial Guinea before legitimizing governments, individuals, actions, and institutions that violated their fundamental rights.

3. Therefore:

We will not seek membership, validation, or cooperation from either body.

We will not acknowledge their declarations, “assistance”, resolutions, or assessment mechanisms.

Sovereignty is not requested.

It is declared, constructed, and defended.

4. Our international alignment is unequivocal:

- ◆ Bilateral cooperation with ethical sovereign states
- ◆ Active participation in the creation of the United States of Africa™ Confederation
- ◆ Alliance with African consciousness networks across the continent and the diaspora
- ◆ Building of a Pan-African, technological, symbolic, and spiritual model outside colonial multilateral frameworks

5. This declaration is final, irrevocable, and public.

We reject external moral tutelage, degrading aid dependency, and any structure that enables oppression under the guise of diplomacy.

We are not members of any club.

We are founders of a new continent.
