**Christian Work:** Helping children get to know God.

**Basic Literacy and Numeracy Instruction:** Assisting local teachers with foundational reading, writing, and math skills, especially in early primary grades or for out-of-school children.

**Language Skills Development:** Helping students improve their proficiency in the official language of instruction (which could be English, French, or another language depending on the region) or supporting the learning of local languages.

**Tutoring and Catch-Up Programs:** Providing extra support to students who are struggling academically or who have fallen behind in their education.

**Mentoring and Guidance:** Serving as a positive role model, offering encouragement, and providing guidance to students on their academic and personal development.

**Facilitating Learning Through Play:** Organizing educational games, songs, and activities, particularly for younger children, to make learning engaging and fun.

**Supporting Special Needs Education:** Assisting teachers in providing individualized support to children with disabilities or learning difficulties, where resources are often limited.

**Life Skills Education:** Facilitating sessions on important life skills such as hygiene, health, communication, problem-solving, and critical thinking.

**Vocational Skills Training:** Depending on the program's focus and the volunteer's skills, assisting with basic vocational training in areas like carpentry, tailoring, craft, computer studies

- **Library and Literacy Initiatives:** Helping to set up and manage small school or community libraries, organizing reading clubs, and promoting a culture of reading.
- **Resource Mobilization:** Fundraising for the project.

#### **Support to Educators and the Program:**

- **Teacher Training and Support:** Assisting local teachers with lesson planning, curriculum development, and innovative teaching methodologies.
- **Resource Development and Creation:** Helping to create low-cost, locally relevant teaching materials using available resources.
- **Classroom Management Support:** Assisting teachers with organizing the classroom, managing student behaviour, and creating a positive learning environment.
- **Administrative Assistance:** Helping with basic administrative tasks such as record-keeping, organizing materials, and communication.
- **Community Engagement and Mobilization:** Working with local communities to encourage school enrolment, parental involvement in education, and community support for learning initiatives.
- **Monitoring and Evaluation:** Assisting with data collection and basic monitoring of the program's impact.
- **Hygiene and Health Education:** Promoting awareness and good practices related to hygiene and health within the school and community.
- **Environmental Education:** Raising awareness about environmental issues and promoting sustainable practices.
- **Facilitating Workshops and Seminars:** Organizing and leading workshops for teachers, parents, or community members on relevant educational topics
