	We are not expected to gain the Presidents award this year. Whilst we have continued to fulfil the required sections of the presidents award program and would have been in a comfortable position to achieve Silver, we fell short in the basic requirements regarding technical meetings. A minimum of 3 technical meetings are required each program year and we were only able to deliver 1 meeting due to being let down by potential speakers and venues. This has been a challenge for the section and we are finding it more difficult to secure speakers and venues to host us due to our lower engagement and attendance when we are putting gon the events. Nathan has submitted a comprehensive summary of our activity to ASNT for the 24/25 year in the hopes that our clear commitment to continued support section may help us to achieve the presidents award anyway.

7.	(T) Future Meetings/Programme No future meetings have been agreed as yet. Section officers met on 19th May and had a frank discussion regarding future meetings and the purpose of the section. Due to lack of engagement, we questioned whether there was any real future for the section. If we arrange meetings but have little to no attendance, then what are we getting out of continuing to run the section. We always wanted in person meetings, however this is not necessarily the best way forward. NB has been working with Onestop NDT and hopes that he may be able to leverage this to a technical session. TF suggested a core 3 technical meetings held only virtually, with the potential for additional onsite/social in person meetings. TF has spoken with BINDT Yorkshire Branch and proposed to hold joint meetings. This branch have not met in the past 2 years and had become dormant. This branch was chosen specifically because they, like NATL have always had strong links with NDT training schools in the Sheffield area. This will hopefully gain some traction and we will be able to set at least 1 joint meeting. S. 8.	(T) SOC (Section Operations Council TF began his term as Chair of SOC for ASNT in 2025. SOC and ASNT as a whole has struggled in the past couple of years with section engagement. This coincided with a change to both the presidents points structure and also to funding model, which lead to many sections feeling cut off and abandoned by ASNT. The management structure also changed within ASNT meaning that the Sections resource was reduced and no longer had a dedicated member of staff for Sections. As a result, TF has called a meeting of sections to understand the current frustrations and define a roadmap to get sections re-engaged.
