Then head south to Naples, the gateway to the ruins of Pompeii and the sun-drenched Amalfi Coast. From Roman ruins and scenic coastlines to Neapolitan puppet shows and fresh sfogliatella, this curated itinerary is a perfect balance of history, artistry, and soul-stirring beauty-designed for travelers who seek meaning behind every masterpiece and memory.

Best time: April - June or September - October

DAY 1: Arrival in Rome - Begin Your Italian Adventure

UNESCO World Heritage Site rich in ancient landmarks and vibrant piazzas.

• After check-in and some rest, set out for an evening walking tour of Rome's most iconic

sights:

Toss a coin for luck at the **Trevi Fountain**

Climb the elegant **Spanish Steps**

Soak in the lively atmosphere of Piazza Navona, with its stunning fountains and street

performers

• Cap off your first night with a welcome dinner featuring live opera or a

classical music performance, offering a taste of Italy's rich cultural heritage.

DAY 3: Rome – Ancient Marvels & Vatican Treasures

DAY 4: Rome to Florence - Renaissance Splendour & Tuscan Traditions

- Arrive in **Florence**, the cradle of the Renaissance, and begin exploring its architectural and artistic wonders:
 - Admire the breathtaking **Duomo di Firenze** (Cathedral of Santa Maria del Fiore), crowned by Brunelleschi's iconic dome
 - Step inside the ornate Baptistery, known for its golden mosaics and the "Gates of Paradise"
 - Climb or photograph Giotto's Campanile for a striking view of the Florence skyline
- Continue your walking tour through the Piazza della Signoria, an open-air museum of Renaissance sculpture, and enjoy a stroll along the Ponte Vecchio, Florence's famed medieval bridge lined with goldsmith shops.
- In the evening, immerse yourself in Tuscan culture with a folk music and dance performance over a traditional Florentine dinner.

 - Continue to the **Accademia Gallery** to stand before the awe-inspiring **Michelangelo's David**, a masterpiece of sculptural perfection
- In the afternoon, delve into Florence's living traditions with a **hands-on artisan workshop**:
 - Choose between **leather crafting**—a centuries-old Florentine specialty—or the art of **marbled paper-making**, a cherished local technique
- Enjoy a relaxed evening exploring Florence at your own pace—perhaps with a sunset walk to **Piazzale Michelangelo** or a quiet dinner in the **Oltrarno** district.

DAY 6: Florence - Day Excursion to Pisa

• Today offers a choice of unforgettable day trip, highlighting a different facet of Tuscany's UNESCO-listed heritage:

Pisa - Iconic Architecture & the Leaning Tower

- Travel to Pisa (approx. 1 hour by train) to explore the stunning Piazza dei Miracoli, a UNESCO World Heritage Site
 - o Climb the world-famous **Leaning Tower of Pisa** for panoramic views
 - Visit the Cathedral of Santa Maria Assunta and the Baptistery, remarkable examples of Romanesque architecture

Return to Florence. Dinner & overnight at hotel in Florence

DAY 7: Florence to Venice - Grand Canals & Cultural Elegance

- Board a **high-speed train from Florence to Venice** (approx. 2 hours), arriving in the enchanting city built on water. Transfer by **vaporetto (water bus)** or private boat to your hotel in the historic centre.
- Spend your afternoon discovering the heart of **Venice's UNESCO World Heritage-listed treasures**:
 - Admire the golden mosaics and Byzantine grandeur of St. Mark's Basilica
 - Tour the opulent **Doge's Palace**, once the seat of Venetian power
 - Walk across the legendary **Bridge of Sighs**, connecting history with romance
- In the evening, immerse yourself in Venice's rich cultural traditions with a **Venetian masquerade ball experience**—complete with masks, period costumes, and classical music—or enjoy a **baroque concert in a historic palazzo** for a refined musical escape.

DAY 8: Venice - Island Hopping & Hands-On Craft

• After breakfast, embark on a morning boat trip across the Venetian Lagoon to explore

two of its most enchanting islands:

Murano – Discover the age-old art of **glassblowing** with a live demonstration at a

traditional glass factory

• Burano – Wander among the island's vibrantly painted houses and observe the

delicate tradition of **lace-making**, a time-honored Venetian craft

• Return to Venice in the afternoon for a unique Venetian carnival mask-making

workshop. Learn from local artisans how to create your own decorative mask using techniques

passed down through generations.

• Optional: End your day with a romantic gondola ride, drifting through the canals and

under ancient bridges as the sun sets over the city.

DAY 10: Day Trip - Pompeii Ruins or Amalfi Coast Beauty

Today, choose between two iconic UNESCO World Heritage Sites that showcase southern Italy's rich cultural and natural heritage:

Pompeii & Herculaneum - Echoes of Ancient Rome

- Step back in time with a **guided tour of Pompeii**, the remarkably preserved Roman city frozen by the eruption of Mount Vesuvius
- Continue to Herculaneum, a smaller but more intimate archaeological site known for its vivid frescoes and detailed houses
- Learn about daily life in ancient Rome while walking through streets, forums, and villas
- Return to **Naples by evening** and immerse yourself in local culture with a performance of **Neapolitan music** or a **traditional puppet theatre show**, featuring the iconic **Pulcinella**, a symbol of Neapolitan folk tradition.

- Transfer to **Naples International Airport** for your onward journey, carrying unforgettable memories of Italy's art, history, and culture.
