# DAY 6: Kuala Lumpur - Culture, Temples & Traditional Crafts

- Batu Caves Climb the colourful staircase to this iconic Hindu shrine set within a dramatic limestone cavern, home to the towering statue of Lord Murugan and sacred cave temples.
- **Thean Hou Temple** Visit one of Southeast Asia's oldest and most ornate Chinese temples, dedicated to the Goddess of the Sea and offering panoramic views of the city.
- Choose between a visit to the Islamic Arts Museum Malaysia, renowned for its exquisite collection of Islamic calligraphy, textiles, and ceramics, or a serene walk through the nearby National Mosque (Masjid Negara), a symbol of Malaysia's Islamic heritage.

# **Cultural Craft Stop:**

Visit the world-renowned Royal Selangor Pewter Factory for a guided tour of traditional pewtersmithing techniques, or opt for a hands-on batik painting workshop to create your own piece of Malaysian textile art.

- Khoo Kongsi Clan House Admire the intricate wood carvings and opulent design of this 19th-century Chinese clan house, a symbol of Penang's Hokkien heritage.
- **Cheong Fatt Tze Mansion (The Blue Mansion)** Take a guided tour of this iconic indigo-blue heritage home, blending Eastern and Western architecture with a fascinating personal history.
- Pinang Peranakan Mansion Step into the opulent lifestyle of the Straits Chinese with a visit to this beautifully restored Baba-Nyonya home, filled with antiques and artefacts.

#### **Creative & Craft Experiences:**

- Embark on a George Town street art walk, spotting iconic murals like "Kids on a Bicycle" and other hidden gems tucked away in alleyways.
- Enjoy a hands-on batik painting session or browse a traditional Penang spice shop to take home fragrant local flavours.

# **Evening Highlight:**

Dive into Penang's legendary street food scene at a **night market**—choose between the bustling stalls of Gurney Drive or the beachside charm of Batu Ferringhi, both offering a feast of local delights.

### DAY 10: Penang to Kuala Lumpur / Singapore – Departure or Langkawi Extension

After breakfast, check out from your hotel and prepare for your return journey or a relaxing beach getaway.

### **Departure Options:**

- Take a short domestic flight from Penang to Kuala Lumpur or directly to **Singapore** for your onward international departure.
- Alternatively, continue your journey with a tropical **Langkawi Island extension**.

#### DAY 11: Penang to Sandakan (Borneo) – Into the Heart of the Rainforest

Begin your Borneo wildlife adventure with a domestic flight from Penang to Sandakan, transiting via Kuala Lumpur. Upon arrival in Sandakan (Sabah, Malaysian Borneo), enjoy a scenic 30-minute transfer to Sepilok, a lush green haven known for its wildlife sanctuaries and tropical rainforests.

#### **Accommodation:**

Check into a charming jungle lodge near Sepilok, where nature surrounds you and tranquility sets the tone.

#### **Evening Activity:**

Choose between a guided nature walk or a night safari at the Rainforest **Discovery Centre**, offering the chance to spot nocturnal wildlife, exotic birds, and the rich biodiversity of the Bornean rainforest under starlit skies.

# DAY 12: Sepilok – Orangutans, Sun Bears & Jungle Encounters

Today is dedicated to exploring the **unique wildlife of Borneo** in the lush rainforests around **Sepilok**, one of Malaysia's most important conservation hubs.

### **Morning Wildlife Encounters:**

- Visit the world-renowned **Sepilok Orangutan Rehabilitation Centre** to witness the morning feeding session and observe these incredible primates in their semi-wild habitat as they swing freely through the trees.
- Just next door, explore the Bornean Sun Bear Conservation Centre, home to the world's smallest bear species, rescued and rehabilitated in a natural forest setting.

# **Afternoon Options:**

- Return to Sepilok for the afternoon orangutan feeding, or take a guided nature walk through nearby forest trails for birdwatching and plant discovery.
- Alternatively, relax at your eco-lodge, or choose to visit the Labuk Bay Proboscis Monkey Sanctuary, where you can see these long-nosed primates in their native mangrove environment.

# DAY 13: Kinabatangan River Safari – Wildlife & Riverside Adventure

Depart Sepilok this morning for a scenic 2-hour transfer to the Kinabatangan River, one of Borneo's most biodiverse wildlife hotspots.

#### **Accommodation:**

Check into a charming riverside lodge nestled in the heart of the rainforest, offering an immersive nature experience.

#### Wildlife Activities:

- Embark on an afternoon boat cruise along the Kinabatangan River, where you may spot wild orangutans, elusive pygmy elephants, colorful hornbills, and other exotic wildlife in their natural habitat.
- As dusk falls, choose between a **night walk** through the jungle trails or a **night river** cruise, perfect for spotting nocturnal creatures like civets, slow lorises, and tree frogs.

# DAY 14: Kinabatangan to Sandakan – Flight to Kuala Lumpur & Evening in the City

After an early breakfast at your riverside lodge, depart Kinabatangan for the approximately 2hour scenic drive back to Sandakan Airport.

Catch your midday or early afternoon flight from Sandakan to Kuala Lumpur. Upon arrival in Kuala Lumpur, check into a conveniently located hotel near the city center or KLIA if you prefer proximity to the airport.

### **Afternoon & Evening Activities:**

- Enjoy shopping at Bukit Bintang or Pavilion KL, two of Kuala Lumpur's premier shopping districts featuring everything from luxury brands to local boutiques.
- Savor a delicious Malaysian dinner at Jalan Alor Food Street, famous for its vibrant atmosphere and authentic street food.
- Return to your hotel for a restful overnight stay
