

Silk Neckbow

Cut out in Silk Taffeta

- 1-2 pieces 12 x 5 inches (for the bow portion, and the tail if desired)
- One piece 3x3 inches (for the center)

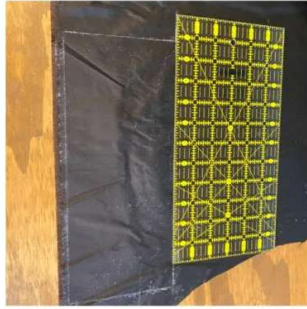
Step 1: Take Bow portion, fold in half, and sew one corner and side with a 1/2 seam allowance. Flip it inside out and press.

Step 2: fold the sides into the back and overlap them by 1/4 – 1/2 inch, sew down.

Step 3: Take needle, and sew the center with big stitches, and yank the thread to create bunching. I usually do this two times, and then wrap the thread around the middle a few times for extra stability.

Step 4: Sew center with 1/2 seam allowance to make a 1 inch tube. I didn't bother sewing the ends, you can turn them under, while you wrap it around. Flip inside out, press.

Step 5: If you want the ties, measure the length of tie you want. I made mine the same as the bow, and sewed with a 1/2 seam allowance. You can point the ends if you desire, or fringe. For fringe, I left 1 inch unsewn, and used a pin to pluck the threads a few at a time.



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
