## Peterson's 1860 Braided Scarf

## **Materials**

- 1.5 oz Color A Sport or DK Weight
- 1.5 oz Color B Sport or DK Weight
- 1.5 oz Color C Sport or DK Weight
- Size 6 Knitting Needles
- Tapestry Needle
- Size: 46 inches long (tassels not included) X 3 inches wide.

## **Let's Start Knitting**

- **Step 1:** Cast on 7 stitches
- **Step 2:** Knit back and forth in garter stitch till desired length. I knit until mine was 50 inches, and it made a 46 inch braided scarf.
- **Step 3:** Bind off, dropping the 4th stitch. Run the dropped stitch all the way down to the bottom.



Step 4: Knit all three of your strands for the scarf.

**Step 5**: Sew all three strands on one side, into a rounded tip.

Step 6: Lay flat onto floor or a table and separate all three strands. Start braiding. I recommend laying flat to braid, as then you can get a nice tension and a flat braid.

**Step 7:** Sewn together the other side, into a rounded tip.

Step 8: Make two tassels. I wrapped three strands around a 6 inch quilting ruler 15 times. (So 45 wraps).
