This project is easy enough to be great for beginning quilters and will be great fun for our experienced members as we enjoy the camaraderie and banter that usually ensues. Workshop participants will need 2 yards of pre-quilted double-sided fabric and $\frac{1}{2}$ yard of coordinating fabric for the binding. Libby recommends size 16/100 denim or sharp sewing machine needles. We will have a completed bag and a signup sheet at our April meeting. There is no charge to members for this workshop; the fee for non-members is \$15.00.


Mission Statement
