

# Psalms of Archangel Gabriel

## 109 The Wisdom of the Nenuphar.

1. It is good that man can have perfect magical writings to contemplate and meditate on.<sup>1</sup> In this way he can concentrate and nourish a higher world inside him.
2. Very often, men make the divine world abstract, with ideas and beliefs far removed from their lives and essential concerns. Such an attitude weakens the Light in the life of man.
3. Perhaps this new revelation of the Nenuphar flower in the lake of Gabriel will allow man to awaken and understand who he is and what he has to do with his life.
4. It would be intelligent to make a garden of nenuphars so that those who want to can meditate in its atmosphere, while striving to talk with the beings that will come to settle and rest in this beauty, in this perfect writing.
5. Men have to concentrate to the point of really understanding this wisdom that shows them clearly that without the divine world, they cannot live. Such an understanding is vital for the happy destiny of man and can only be born in the atmosphere of such a magical garden.
6. My greatest satisfaction is that men awaken and commit themselves consciously, that they become responsible for what they have understood in their lives, for example, that man cannot exist or above all become alive, enter life without a higher world.
7. Man is not asked to be a sage, a great master or a powerful magician, but simply to be a faithful servant of what he has understood that is higher and better.
8. Let men finally give the divine world the means to touch them, to awaken them in what is true and pure.
