

Psalms of Archangel Gabriel

20 Taste the fruit to know its flavour.

1. Look at all those civilizations, all those traditions, all those beings who have left traces of their passage. Life is a continuity and you live in the house that someone else built, very often you walk in the steps that another took on the path before you.
2. There has to be a resonance between what you carry in the deepest part of you and what you find in your life as conditions of existence. Then you will know your path, the tradition that you need to follow in order to fulfill yourself.
3. Know that in the world something corresponds to you. This is what you need to find.
4. Do not be content with the appearances, but enter into the depths.
5. If you really want to find out who you are, what you have to do, what your aptitudes are, your true projects, then, do not be the one who contents himself with looking at the orange, its beauty, its colour, but be courageous: tear the veil, remove its peel and taste the fruit.
6. In the deepest part of him, man feels in affinity with those beings of the past who constantly offered humanity paths and directions. Yes, through all these tracks left behind, a life tickles man so that he awakens.
7. An inner life is capable of creating sometimes painful circumstances so that man becomes aware of the divine life at the heart of his being.
8. Be intelligent, aware. Understand that the suffering of those beings who came in the past was not to live with the divine, but to transmit the greatness, the purity of the teaching of the Light to men, to speak to them about the taste of the orange.
9. Do not be like the majority of men who satisfy themselves with an understanding, a colour, a smell, shapes or fragrances. Be courageous and intrepid so as to defy all your limitations, to triumph over the test of the appearances, force yourself if need be, but finally share in the experience of the Light by you also tasting the fruit.
10. No being on earth will transmit to you the real taste of the fruit. Only your own senses will allow you to taste its flavour, to grasp the sweetness or even the bitterness of what a divine life can be. Tasting the fruit yourself will not only make you discover and appreciate a whole world, but more than that, it will inspire your whole life, and will even inspire others by what emanates from you, the perfume of your life.
11. Awaken audacity, bravery, courage, and go and taste the fruit to discover and experience the presence of your soul and of the Angels in you.
