

Psalm of Archangel Gabriel

207. Si tu veux rencontrer Dieu, cultive la pureté

1. I love the man who approaches me in purity.
2. He who aspires to walk toward the Light must work to acquire purity. It is not a question of being pure or impure, of being without imperfection or opposition; no, one must have found a balance and opened a space where purity is possible, alive, where it can grow as a state of being. First, it is born in the heart, and then it develops in the head and the will.
3. Man must approach me being conscious, awake, and having cultivated this space of purity within himself.
4. The person who approaches me can only be a disciple, that is, a being who has encountered and recognized the Teaching, who has bowed before it and decided to walk on a path of transformation to grow what is pure and true.
5. When purity touches the center of thought, it becomes a light of intelligence, clarity, obviousness. It is the birth of gnosis, the direct knowledge that illuminates and makes everything clear. Then everything is in order, everything makes sense. This is the sign that purity reigns in the mind of man.
6. In feelings, purity manifests itself as a permanent state of birth into inner life, of fullness, omnipresence, peace, balance, harmony; it is a gentleness and a certainty, a blossoming in the higher worlds, a subtle enrichment, a presence that envelops, protects, and reveals in all things the path that leads to ennoblement unto perfection.
7. In the will, purity manifests itself as the Light that descends into the darkness to illuminate and heal all things. It then becomes a force, a sacred energy leading to righteous action, to the work that brings forth the greatness and ideal vision of life.
8. Purity allows the divine world to look at the world through the eyes, soul, and deeds of man. Then man is no longer alone, isolated, lost.
9. Purity brings bliss; it is a state of being that fills the inner life and permeates all worlds. Nothing can resist it, for it is the supreme order, the omnipresence of the divine, where all is greatness, wonder, and wisdom.

10. If purity is with you, you will be able to look at imperfection as well as perfection, and nothing will be able to distort or destabilize you, because you will understand that there is meaning, logic, intelligence, and truth in everything.

11. God is truth, and purity is the path that leads to Him. Truth fills everything: it is God. If you are pure, you are with what is, and nothing can oppose the greatness of that. Everything is in order, in harmony, in accordance with the supreme, the divine.

12. When consciousness animates your life and becomes a force, it means that purity is truly anchored in your will; it becomes almost physical, your soul touches matter. All your actions then become a healing for those around you, a blessing, sanctification, liberation, and a force that ennobles and opens up greater possibilities. These are actions filled with soul and intelligence, connected to a higher world, which bring forth the truth.

13. Truth is that which is pure, without falsehood, without blemish, true in every aspect of being, united with the Angels.

14. Know that purity is an ideal, an unavoidable path, a direction to take if you want to meet God. This path is internal and must be developed through the three intelligences within you to manifest itself through the actions of the body finally.

15. Do not let yourself be overwhelmed by superfluous worlds, but seek the essential, cultivate it so that it leads you to a state of fullness, of greatness, toward a state of fulfillment, of greatness, to an ecstasy that strengthens your inner life, balance, composure, and enlightens it. Intelligence enlightens, the heart balances, and the will provides composure.

16. Cultivate candor, higher vision, and strength of soul.

17. The higher vision of the Teaching will awaken your thinking, structure it, and make you see the greatness in all things. It will show you the growing strength, the immensity, and also the will of God, which is wisdom and blessing. Then you will encounter the Good that fills the worlds and the wisdom that governs.

Father Gabriel, how can we find this purity in a world where a powerful whirlwind of frantic life seems to oppose it?

18. Purity is above all an inner state. What is on the outside is only a reflection, a mixture, a bland reproduction, a world that has no meaning, no intelligence, where everything is mixed together, good and evil, beautiful and ugly. It is this confusion that brings impurity and turmoil and cuts man off from the original source; it is a world

without value, without soul, without future, without purpose, without greatness, without anything that transcends death. There may of course be a reflection that awakens you, but the awakening will always be internal and will open up a greater path for you towards the subtle, the immaterial, the soul, the spirit.

19. If you touch the inner center of purity, it will show you the goal, the path to perfection, to the elevation of all the centers of man towards the ultimate, towards a higher world of intelligence, order, and eternity.

20. Do not look upon the world of impurity, waste, recycling, this outer world as an enemy; do not denigrate it, but neither give it a value it does not have. At best, it can be a reflection that awakens the inner self and reveals the royal path of the soul and the divine spirit.

21. Learn to pass through these outer worlds by flying over them, without stopping, without really looking at them, because otherwise you risk being captured and imprisoned by these worlds that are beautiful in appearance but empty of truth.

22. Light the flame of purity within you so that it illuminates your life with the virtues of the Angels in your actions and deeds.

23. Do not worry about the outside world, but focus on the world that lives within you. Go to the Angels, Archangels, and Gods and direct your energy toward greatness and magnificence.

24. Be a good student, not of men, who care only for the body and mortal life, but of Angels, who will awaken your inner life, your true being, and all that is great.

25. Do not focus on what is of no interest.

26. Remember that darkness goes to recycling. Such is the fate of men who live only for the distorted reflections of the outside world.

27. Light goes to Light, but it must remain pure, unmixed.

28. Do not identify with the outside world, do not seek yourself in it, but turn to the source within and find your true origin.

29. Identify with what is true, great, and eternal.

30. Learn to see beyond appearances and you will perceive the boundless path that leads to greatness.
