

Psalms of Archangel Raphael

258 The Being of responsibility.

1. Not only do you speak the word to be parents of God the Light, but in addition, you open the circle of the eternal commitment. This is perfection on earth, but you must be aware of your responsibility. Your responsibility is a gift from God, strength.
2. To be a parent is first of all to meet this being of responsibility.
3. Is man able to be responsible? That is the whole question.
4. Responsibility is the difference between the child and the parent.
5. The child is taken care of by his own inner world and he completely loses interest in his own responsibility, in the breathing and the ambiance that he creates around him. He does not want to be responsible, or see to, take care of what is outside him. He does not want to think differently, find solutions and make sure to take care of the other by really being responsible.
6. Today the world of man has become deeply egoistic and all men are turned towards themselves before everything. When events happen that force them to awaken, they look for a culprit in order to transfer the responsibility to another. This attitude does not generate strength but makes weakness appear.
7. The strength to be a parent is in responsibility.
8. No one can be responsible in place of the parent.
9. A parent is essentially an individualized being who is in the service of a cause and who feels responsible. No one can take this responsibility from him, for it is his being, his rectitude, his dignity, his strength.
10. To be a parent is not to transfer your responsibility to another, society, a world.
11. To be a parent is to feel concerned, and be aware of the influences that your own life is going to have on the environment.
12. The parent is in the centre of everything because he wants to take care and to serve. He is in the centre because he knows that everything has to be good in order for the best conditions to be given so that the child can grow.
13. To be a parent is to plan, to govern, to prepare, anticipate and control. It is not to be an accuser, a moralist who still looks to transfer responsibility on another simply because he does not want to do his share.
14. The moralist says to you everything you have to do because he does not do it himself. In fact, he frees himself from responsibility.
15. To be a parent is not to say that you are responsible, it is to be responsible.
16. I, I say to you that the path of dignity passes through responsibility.
17. It is not the other who must be responsible, it is you.

18. If you are not responsible, you are a child and in this, actually, you must be protected and educated.
19. If you walk on the path of awakening, you must take hold of the staff, the spinal column of responsibility.
20. You alone must be responsible for the life that is yours, for your destiny and for your environment.
21. Everything is a question of exchanges, of breathing, of harmony, of dialogue, of sincerity and of honesty.
22. The relation that you maintain with the invisible worlds is connected to what you carry inside.
23. What you do on the outside must be in perfect harmony with what you are inside and with your heaven, your subtle environment, your alliance with the invisible, otherwise there will be discord in your breath, an incoherence, disrespect, a lack of attention, of consideration.
24. Lack of attention leads to disrespect, which makes egoism, confinement in the illusion appear.
25. Be aware that man is a pillar having to carry worlds that gravitate around him. As a pillar, he receives and he gives, but what does he receive, what does he carry and what does he give? Does he transmit balance, does he show responsibility, does he emphasize good communication, good exchanges? A parent cannot ignore these questions and this knowledge of how to live. It is like the breath that winds and unwinds around the axis that the pillar of man is. This breath is not insignificant, it is energy, soul, intelligence, nourishment passed on to the future that wants to be born at each moment.
26. One who is responsible balances the breaths because he knows to transform everything in order to bring the best to the outside and bring about the triumph of the higher worlds, that is, the omnipresent sacred invisible. This man is a parent, and he will not transfer his responsibility to another higher or lower world, but he will develop strength and intelligence in him to offer the best by himself. He will use all the elements, in all worlds, to bring out the best.
27. The man in illusion believes that he thinks right and does the right act and that it is always the environment that is adverse, that does whatever, that is not favourable, but this is a means to flee his responsibility and his being.
28. The true parent will not wait for the environment to be favourable to take care of his child.
29. The truth is that no environment is unfavourable because life is made up of multiple facets, energies, colours, forms, inspirations that make it rich, splendid.
30. There are worlds that might seem ugly, but it is simply that they are at the beginning.
31. The man who knows what he wants must not busy himself with what is not his business, he must not compare, study what is not useful to the fulfilment of his goal. It is fundamental that his child is warm, is sheltered, has food, air and all the right conditions to evolve and carry out his mission.

32. In all circumstances, there is always a path towards the best, but there is also a multitude of ways to get lost and to lose. It is a question of concentration, of attention, of awakening and of fidelity.

You must always look at what you are and what you can do to balance the worlds, establish the dialogue with the subtle worlds in order to be able to transform the energies at work to ensure that they bring victory, healing, strength around you. In this way you will understand what it means to be a parent and the strength that is hidden in the word “responsibility.”

Olivier Manitara then asked Archangel Raphael:

Father Raphael, must we be responsible for everything that surrounds us and for everything that presents itself to us in life and being invested in it?

Archangel Raphael answered:

34. You must be responsible for your commitment and in perfect concentration you must make sure to lead all the forces and energies that you meet in your life towards the victory of the work.
35. Know that coincidence does not exist.
36. If you meet a being, a circumstance, an event, a thought, a smell, something that makes you react and touches you inside, understand that these are an influence, a breath that come from a world and that bring a world. It can be a physical, subtle, invisible, divine or dark world, it does not matter.
37. Consider that what you meet is only a representative, a messenger that reveals what is produced in the invisible worlds to you.
38. You must always consider that it is a blessing to be able to see, to understand and to act for the best, in perfect concentration.
39. There is nothing worse than to be blind, without intelligence and sterile, without identity, ignorant of who you are and what you have to do. There is nothing worse than to be in the illusion that everything is fine, while a plot is being prepared in the hidden.
40. Everything that is visible is first invisible.
41. Knowledge of the invisible worlds is a necessity.
42. What is done in the hidden worlds always ends up by appearing.
43. If you only live in the visible world, you will be weak and unconscious, ignorant.
44. If you live in the 2 worlds, you will be a true parent, taking care of what is essential and not abdicating your responsibility.
45. One who is ignorant, unconscious, who does not know to read the signs that are sent to him, who does not know to predict the future is at the mercy of events and circumstances. He cannot direct his life and therefore be a parent.
46. A parent is awake because he is responsible. He is always ready to seize the opportunity and confront adversity, not in combat, but precisely in balance and with the will to make a better world appear, a wiser life, full of virtues.
47. Do not accuse or run away because you do not want to be responsible.

48. If you meet worlds, if you are put in front of situations, it is a call to awakening, to concentration, to Initiation and to surpassing yourself.
49. Of course there is a settling of scores and a search for the balance of the worlds.
50. Be a healer and never let any disease install itself in the subtle first to finally appear as inevitable.
51. Before that a sick world takes root in you, through elements, smells, circumstances, words, attitudes, welcome the first messages in a right way and balance them, give them the answer and reorganize the worlds in you and around you so that the dark cannot take a place.
52. Responsibility is the virtue of the parents.
53. A parent is invested in everything and seeks to develop the right vision in order to balance the worlds, heal them and liberate them through the newborn of life.
54. Rest on the pillar of responsibility that unites heaven and earth and do not join in the accusatory energy that pushes you to escape from your responsibilities by pointing the finger at the alleged defects of others, their inadequacies. If you take this path, know that you will not meet divinity, for there is nothing more unpleasant for the higher worlds than a being who is not responsible for his mission on earth.
55. You, the Essenes, you have the mission to bring the being that allows healing and that makes the virtues of the Angels, of the Archangels and the Gods triumph.
