

# Psalms of Archangel Gabriel

## 85 Man must himself become knowledge.

1. When we, the higher world, we approach your world, we observe that only nature is alive. Unfortunately, man is dead because for him existence is only in appearances. He is empty inside, extinguished, does not live with his soul because he has lost the connection with nature, with the Mother, with what is alive in his world. So he turns towards the outside to compensate, fill, hide this inner emptiness, this unease, for deep down he knows that he is dead, that he lives in a world without soul. He creates an artificial world to fill this lack.
2. What the higher intelligence does not accept is that man has knowledge and does not put it into practice, does not make it a hymn to the great and beautiful life. Then knowledge is lost, for it only reinforces death in the world of men.
3. The divine world is another world. It is the kingdom of life. Men, who live like seeds, can only reach this kingdom through flowering.
4. A flower is the victory of life.
5. Spiritualists, mystics turn to the divine world and constantly ask to receive help, answers to their questions. Yet, it is surprising to see that very often, they already have the answers; only, they do not want to enter into the current of life, into transformation, into the application of what they know. Their prayers are a way to run away from themselves and even to run away from the divine world.
6. A man cannot understand more than what he can integrate. If he understands a mystery and does not put it into practice or make it a sacred act of life, no other understanding can be given to him without him falling sick and his destiny being weighed down with an additional burden. There comes then a time when there are no more answers from the divine world, for all knowledge that is not alive ends up by being transformed into waste and increasing death in the world of man.
7. The divine world helps man by giving him the answer according to what he is, what he can understand, what he can do.
8. The victory of knowledge occurs when man receives it from the higher world and puts it into practice to glorify life.
9. If man is truly intelligent, he receives the answer and makes it his own through work, not only in the spheres of the intellect and the heart, but down into the act that glorifies divine life. For example, if a man receives clarity about what peace really is, he must attune everything that lives in him to the Angel of peace and to what he has understood about peace.
10. Man must himself become the knowledge that enlightens him and leads him. In this way he allows the higher light to enter his life and touch the earth.

11. In his ignorance, man thinks that everything is like him, dead. Yet, for the divine world, an answer, an understanding are living beings that approach man with missions to carry out. If man does not welcome them into his house, these are not only offenses but betrayals, for these beings suffer, having been caught by the world of men.
12. The divine world knows that it is dangerous to approach the world of men, for when the missioned ones come close to the earth, they are often led into the world of what has died out, is without soul, without life.
13. If a light comes to see you, welcome it not only in you, but up to the end of your being and your life. Make sure that it becomes victory for life, down into your world. If it is peace that you have understood, you have to carry out a work of peace. Maybe you need to reconcile with your neighbour, with your friend or stop being consumed by despair, driven by certain overwhelming thoughts . . . How do you do this? By truly putting yourself in harmony with the Angel of peace.
14. In a revelation of Light, there cannot be 2 worlds. Man has to harmonize his own world with the higher intelligence to the point of incarnating it for the victory of life, otherwise there cannot be alliance or answer.
15. If you understand something, make it a work that is an offering, a body for the light animating your understanding. Then the knowledge will be alive in you, acting, it will be one with you.
16. Men have to know what they want and learn to develop their will and their ability to concentrate in order to become creators, beings acting in the direction of the light that enlightens them. Then they will gain the Light and life, a body of Light.
17. For the Children of the Light, the greatest blessing on earth today is found in the Essene Nation. When you enter it, you are connected with an Angel. Through a virtue, you can lead this Angel into your life, become his face, hands and feet on earth and be connected through a circle of Angels to a divine work in incarnation in the world of men.
18. The weakness of the Children of the Light is to be dreamers, to let themselves be easily caught by the worlds of illusion. They are hesitant, lack determination, discernment, concentration, ardour. When the answers to all the questions are given to them through the Essene Nation, they refuse to hear them, ignore them. In fact, they do not want to receive the answers and cultivate the connection with a higher world. They just want, like the materialists, to be reassured and reinforce the illusion of the world of appearances that hides the great emptiness that is in them.
19. The Essene Nation is the answer for the world today, but it is not for those who want to keep their illusions; it is for those who want to serve the Light while making their lives a work.
20. For a human being, the most beautiful life is to carry the face and expression of an Angel with truth and purity.
21. So, stop trying to understand everything, especially what is useless, for you overload your lives in the world of death and one day, you will have to explain

- yourselves: you will be asked what you have done with the knowledge you have received.
22. Of course it is wise to want to learn, to want to understand and enlighten the world, but it is even wiser to understand a little truth and make it your own for the glory of life.
  23. What men call “knowledge,” even spiritual, often strengthens their world of death. They accumulate answers, close them up in boxes, like genies prisoners in bottles, put them on shelves and look at them from time to time, when they need them. But this knowledge is outside them; it does not really belong to them. Someone can steal it, make it disappear, and then, what is left?
  24. The Light is alive. It wants to live with man in love, respect, freedom, collaboration and not be captured and imprisoned in the world of death. This attitude is not Essene, for the Essenes take care of the Light and are at its service.
  25. The Light is the common good that must enlighten all beings, not to be led into slavery, but to be honoured as the queen of heaven, the splendour of the Angels.
  26. The Essenes are the true healers on earth. They are generous with life and make the Light live through their own lives dedicated consecrated to the Light in truth, in the Covenant, in solidarity and mutual support.
  27. A little bit of realized knowledge is better than a lot of dead and useless knowledge.
