



# DO SOMETHING – Voting

*The NYS primary for Nov. 3, 2026 elections is June 23 (early voting: June 13 – June 21).*

- Register, check registration, polling place, election dates, and hours (use official sites)  
[www.vote.nyc](http://www.vote.nyc) (NYC)  
<https://voterlookup.elections.ny.gov/> (NYS)  
[www.vote411.org/](http://www.vote411.org/) (who and what's on the ballot by state); [vote.org](http://vote.org)
- Note: You cannot vote in the primary if you registered as “independent,” that is, with no political party affiliation.
- Make a voting plan. Urge others to do the same, remind them to vote and what's at stake, help them to get to the polls if needed.
- Contact state reps ([NYS Assembly](#), [NYS Senate](#)) to lobby for safe and fair elections.
- Oppose the SAVE ACT and MEGA Act:
