At a Glance

M.B. Govt. Post Graduate College Haldwani was established in the Year 1960 as a private degree college sponsored by Moti Ram Babu Ram Educational Trust to cater to the needs of higher education of the youth of Haldwani and surrounding areas. It was affiliated to Agra University till 1973 and with the establishment of the Kumaun University, Nainital in 1974, the College got affiliated to it. In the larger interest of the students and other stakeholders Government of Uttar Pradesh took over the management of the college from Moti Ram Babu Ram Educational Trust in 1982, and so, it became a government college managed and funded by the state government. It is recognized by University Grants Commission under section 2[F] and 12[b] of the UGC act 1956. This is the largest government college of Uttarakhand with almost 12,000 regular students.



Above grant is subject to the following conditions:

1. The institute must organize a minimum of 05 lectures (online mode) throughout the year. Rest can be organized via offline/hybrid mode.
2. The Institute/University must organize at least one activity related to IPR awareness in one month. The funds must not be utilized in one/two day workshop. The Honorarium for experts would be paid as per institute/university norms.
3. Proceedings and annual Progress report would be sent to the council by the IPR cell coordinator through Head of the Institutions.
4. The institute would highlight the Financial Support and role of UCOST Dehradun by giving due acknowledgment at all the forums, publications, pamphlets, banners and proceedings.

5. The grant shall be exclusively utilized for the purpose for which it is sanctioned. The money would not be diverted for any other purpose under any circumstance; even for temporary periods.

6. The accounts will be audited according to the procedure of the host institution. Audited Utilization Certificate (UC) and Statement of Expenditure (SOE) duly signed by competent authority would be submitted to UCOST after completion of event/financial Year. In case of Private Institutions/Universities, Audited documents must be mandatorily counter signed by Chartered Accountant (CA).

7. Unspent balance, if any, from the sanctioned grant would be returned to UCOST through bank draft in favor of "The Director General, UCOST" payable at Dehradun as earliest as possible.

8. Information about IPR applications received by the IPR cell shall be immediately submitted to UCOST.

9. Participation of UCOST PIC Official is mandatory in every program organized by IPR Cell. About its forthcoming IPR awareness programmes, one month advance intimation would be sent and IPR experts from UCOST would be invited as guest/invited speakers.

10. The account of the programme shall be open to inspection by 'sanctioning authority/audit whenever the institution is called upon to do so.


