2. Categories of Data Collected and Purpose

Purpose / Function	Data Categories	Legal Basis (GDPR)
Website Contact / Inquiries	Name, work email, phone number, company name, message text.	Art. 6(1)(f) – Legitimate Interest in handling business inquiries.
Platform Account Management	User login credentials, business email, role/permissions.	Art. 6(1)(b) – Performance of contract.
Website Analytics & Security	IP address, browser type, device logs, cookie telemetry.	Art. 6(1)(a) – Consent (Cookies) / Art. 6(1)(f) (Security).

3. Data Retention

Personal data collected through website contact forms or platform account administrative records is retained for as long as necessary to fulfill the operational purpose, or up to 5 years pursuant to Danish bookkeeping rules (*Bogføringsloven*) where relevant.

4. Third-Party Data Processors and Transfers

We utilize trusted third-party service providers to host our website, run cloud infrastructure, and manage communications.

- All platform data is hosted on servers located within the European Economic Area (EEA).
- Where data transfers outside the EEA occur (e.g., global cloud subprocessors), such transfers are governed by EU Standard Contractual Clauses (SCCs) or adequacy decisions.

5. Your Rights as a Data Subject

Under GDPR Articles 15–22, you have the right to:

1. Request access to your personal data.
2. Request rectification or erasure ("Right to be Forgotten") of inaccurate data.
3. Restrict or object to processing.
4. Request data portability.
