Stone Heritage Polished Concrete Care and Maintenance

Stone Heritage polish concrete floors are polished and penetrating concrete sealer applied to harden and densify the surface so to your floor will stay looking good for longer.

It is normal for a polished concrete floor to have some blemishes or discoloration, small pits and small cracks. We work closely with builders to minimize these natural inherent traits but every floor is unique and cannot be replicated due to the hundreds of factors that effect concrete construction.

Care and Cleaning

- Micro Fiber mops or a soft broom are ideal for day to day cleaning
- It is recommended that a neutral PH cleaner is used and not products that have ammonia or aggressive chemicals.
- For Large areas it is recommended that a buffing machine be used on a regular basis.
- Steam mops are a good option for cleaning in areas where needed.
- If oil, wine or citrus juice is spilt it is recommended this be cleaned off the surface immediately
- Furniture should have felt pads underneath legs to avoid scratching
- To remove scratches or marks use a green 3M pot scrub pad or a small amount of vehicle cut and polish compound
- It is ok to wear your shoes inside on a polished concrete floor
- **Do not** use Duct Tape or PVC/plastic tapes on floor as it will stain the concrete. Use only low tack paper painter tape.

Long Term Maintenance

Re seal every 5 years if needed
