

How to Get Prayers Answered (Revised)

Discover 9 Biblical Principles for Powerful and Effective Prayer

Relationship with God (John 15:7)

- Abide in Christ; let His Word shape your prayers.
- Prayer flows from a close relationship, not rituals.

Pray in Faith (Mark 11:24)

- Believe God is already working before you see results.
- Faith is trusting like a seed planted in soil.

Pray According to God's Will (1 John 5:14-15)

- Prayers grounded in God's promises are always heard.
- Use Scripture as your prayer foundation.

Obedience (1 John 3:22)

- Surrender our desires to God's purpose.
- A willing heart stays in alignment with God.

Keep the Channel Clear (Psalm 66:18)

- Unconfessed sin blocks communication with God.
- Confession restores the line of prayer.

Persistence and Patience (Luke 18:1-8)

- God honors consistent, persevering prayer.
- Delays are not denials—waiting builds trust.

Gratitude and Praise (Philippians 4:6-7)

- Pray with thanksgiving, not just requests.
- Gratitude brings peace and recognition of God's work.

Power of Agreement (Matthew 18:19-20)

- Praying with others multiplies effectiveness.
- Unity strengthens the prayer of agreement.

Expectancy and Listening (Isaiah 30:21)

- Be open to yes, no, wait, or redirection.
- Prayer involves listening as well as speaking.
