Did You Know?

ARC Approval Is Required Before Many Exterior Home Projects Begin

To help maintain the appearance and harmony of our community, homeowners must submit an **Architectural Review Committee (ARC) Request Form** before starting many exterior home projects.

Examples of projects that require ARC approval include:

- Exterior painting or color changes
- Roof replacement or roofing color/material changes
- Landscaping projects or tree removal
- Decks, patios, porches, or additions
- Window or door replacements with a different style
- Driveway or walkway changes
- Any exterior modifications to the home or property

What to include with your ARC request:

Depending on the project, homeowners may need to provide:

- Description of the project
- Dimensions and materials
- Paint color samples or information
- Drawings, plans, or property plats

Important Reminders:

- ARC approval must be received before work begins
- The review process may take up to two weeks
- Homeowners are responsible for obtaining any required county permits

If you are unsure whether your project requires approval, please **contact the Montpelier Village Club office** before beginning work.

Clubhouse & Amenities Access Requirements

To ensure proper access to the clubhouse and community amenities, the following forms and documents must be on file with the Association.

Homeowners Must Complete:

- Clubhouse Key Card Agreement
- Clubhouse Facilities Use Liability Waiver

Owners with Rental Properties Must Also Provide:

- Assignment of Rights to Tenant
(This form must be updated with every new tenant occupying the home.)
- Current Lease & Tenant Contact Information
(This information must be updated with every new tenant occupying the home.)

Tenants Must Have on File:

- Clubhouse Key Card Agreement
- Clubhouse Facilities Use Liability Waiver
- Current Government-Issued ID
