



THE PERTH AGREEMENT

Executive Summary

A Universal Commitment: One Meal, Every Person, Every Day

The Perth Agreement sets forward a simple and transformative proposition:

Every human being on Earth should receive the equivalent of one nutritious meal every single day — freely, equally, and without conditions.

This initiative is not charity, welfare, or geopolitics.

It is a foundational human guarantee — a reset point for dignity, stability, and peace.

At its core is a single principle:

No person should ever go hungry. Not one. Not anywhere.

What the Perth Agreement Proposes

- The Perth Agreement is a jointly signed document by leaders of major religious houses and Perth-based representatives. It encourages the academic, ethical, and moral pursuit of global improvement. At its centre is a 21-year framework in which every individual receives one meal token per day.
- This token:
 - is universal (issued to every person in every nation)
 - is equal (the same daily amount for all)
 - is voluntary (no nation or person is compelled to participate)
 - is transparent (recorded on an open, auditable ledger)
 - is redeemable for food or equivalent value
 - is stable (anchored to the value of a basic meal: rice and vegetables)
 - is accumulative (unused tokens remain with the individual forever)

Why Perth?

Perth is one of the world's most isolated, peaceful, and politically stable cities.

Its distance from geopolitical centres allows ideas to be shaped without external pressure, conflict, or historic entanglement. People from many cultures and traditions live alongside one another in relative harmony, making Perth an ideal birthplace for a neutral humanitarian initiative.

How the Perth Agreement Began

This initiative began with a question asked by a five-year-old child in Mackay, Queensland:

“Why are children starving?”

Decades later, that question still stands — and now the world has the tools to answer it.

Multiple AI analyses have reviewed the concept through economic, mathematical, ethical, and logistical frameworks. None have identified a structural barrier preventing the idea from working.
