COMPETITION CONDITIONS

Participants

Players with a P&P License from any European country and Spanish players with a valid license from the RFEG may participate; Amateur or professional license. Maximum 160 players

Registered players must have a valid license granted by one of the IPPA's affiliated European members, and therefore any player will be accepted by the organization, unless rejected by the respective Federation, Association or Union.

Registration Fee

Registration fee: 75€ each player. This amount includes: European Championship fee, practice day, welcome cocktail and awards ceremony.

Player Registration

Depending on the place of origin or nationality, the dates for registration will be as follows:

a) European Players:

- 60 places: for all players from any European country, the registration period will be open until 23:59 on April 30, 2026, with the first 60 who register and pay the fee to the bank account being admitted: IBAN ES6930700034866462511624 (BIC: BCOEESMM070); Sending all registration documentation to: inforiocabe@gmail.com

A Waiting List will be established to fill vacancies, being awarded in order of registration of the players.

- 15 places: from May 1, 2026, 15 additional places will be saved for players on the waiting list or who register until 11:59 p.m. on May 31, 2026, with the same registration system.

- Waiting list: a waiting list will be created in www.golfriocabe.es from June 1, 2026, to fill possible free places

B) Spanish Players:

- 60 places: Spanish players (mandatory license from the Royal Spanish Golf Federation) must pre-register on a list that will be open from March 1 to 23:59 on April 30, 2026. In order from lowest to highest handicap (RFEG world championship), 60 places will be reserved and will have a deadline, with prior notice from the organization, to register definitively from May 1 to 31, 2026. This same list will be valid as a waiting list to occupy possible free places

- 10 places. 10 places are reserved to be occupied by the first 10 winners (or subsequent up to 10) of the tournament to be held at Club Rio Cabe from June 19 to 21 who could not have registered in the previous lists.

Likewise, a waiting list will be created to cover the places that may remain for International and Spanish players with at least 10 places

Prior to the start of the championship, (12:00 noon 1 June 2026), the remaining places of the competition will be filled in the following order: one player from each list (1st and 2nd International – 1st Spanish – 3rd and 4th International – 2nd Spanish – and successively) until all the places have been filled.

The Competition Committee reserves five places, regardless of the place of residence of the players.

COMPETITION RULES

Flags

In Pitch & Putt (IPPA) competitions, the tees will be set at a minimum distance of 40 meters and a maximum of 90 meters. The distance from the 18-hole course of the Rio Cabe club is 1,200 meters. The Committee and/or the Tournament Director will decide the position of the flags in each round.

Ball Accommodation

The use of tee at the Tee Off is mandatory

The tee or support or similar object to accommodate the ball at the teeing place must comply with the provisions of the Rules of Golf. In case of using a support or object provided with a rope or similar, it will be mandatory to have another support or similar object at the other end.

The combination of supports will not be allowed and under no circumstances will be allowed to indicate the direction of the game, measure the intensity or direction of the wind. (RFEG Green Paper, Chapter IV, page 22, Part g-(d)).

Departure location

IPPA tour. The boundaries of the Tee Place of each hole are defined by the mat located on each of them. The ball must be placed on the carpet. The player can stand outside of it.

Number of Clubs

As set out in IPPA regulations, the use of a maximum of 3 clubs (one of which must be the putter) is permitted.

Order of play

The Test Committee will establish the pairings and start times

Caddies

Not allowed.

Distance Meters

The use of any type of object, laser meter or GPS to measure distances is PROHIBITED. The Committee will provide players with this information.

Tiebreakers

In the event of a tie for the absolute champion, it will be resolved by Play-offs (Sudden Death) on the 18th hole, as many times as necessary until a winner is obtained. For the rest of the classified and categories, it will be decided by the best card at the start of the 3rd round, if the tie persists for the best card in the 2nd round, if the tie persists, by the best card of the 1st round; if the tie persists, the last card will be taken for the best 9 (10 to 18) last holes; if not 6 (13 to 18) last holes; if not 3 (16 to 18) last holes, or if not, better hole 18. If there is still a tie, it will be resolved by lot.

AWARDS

- 1st Champion: €1,000 + Trophy
- 2nd Runner-up: 750 € + Trophy
- 3rd: 500 € + Trophy
- 4th: 400 €
- 5th: 300 €
- 6th: 200 €
- 7th: 150 €

Categories:

- Senior: €150 + Trophy (minimum quorum 10 players)
- Women: €150 + Trophy (minimum quorum 10 players)
- Youth (until 2008): €150 + Trophy (minimum quorum 10 players)

The prizes for the juniors will be vouchers equivalent to the amount

Prizes cannot be accumulated.

COMPETITION COMMITTEE

The Organization formed by the IPPA and the Rio Cabe Club will appoint the Committee and Referees of the Competition that will be announced well in advance.

The Competition Committee reserves the right to decide on organizational issues, interpretation of current regulations.

Likewise, the Committee may modify the number of registered players and/or cancel any of the categories in order accommodate high demand from international players.
